REACTIONS TO "WE ARE IT!"

So I guess us men will just stay home & change diapers & cook & keep the Homes going or hold System jobs to support'm." I guess in a way I was murmuring, LFM. But I read today's text in a whole new light. The part that said "You Heaven's boys & girls"—he even put it first! All of a sudden I could see it & started getting really excited! In a way I guess I don't really care who's going to be used. I mean it's all for God's glory. And if the Lord decides to use me, great! But I won't murmur any more or be jealous any more of the girls, because it's the Lord's work, & it really doesn't matter as long as the Lord gets the credit! (John D.)

REACTION TO "PERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS"

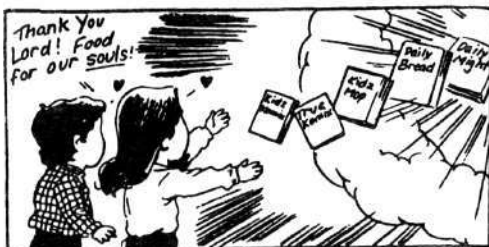
REACTIONS TO "YOU ARE WHAT YOU READ"

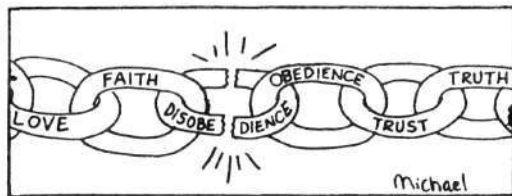
