## Japan TTC Teens Thank God for New Lives!

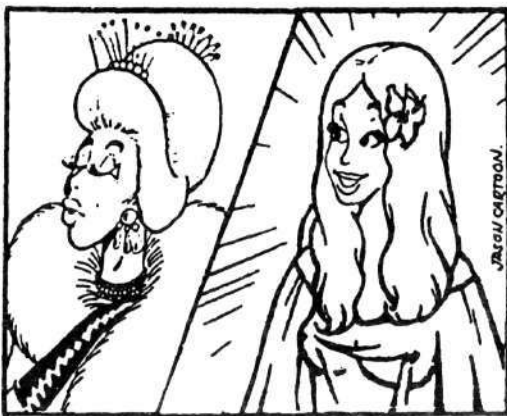

So this TTC, DV, is going to plug them into the real source of inspiration so they can have a proper perspective in their appetites & desires, not looking to videos & going out, etc. as the things to look forward to to keep inspired, but merely as a break before diving back into what they know they need to be doing for the Lord!
