

Sunday Fellowship At MWM!

—How they conduct it!—Tips on encouraging children to participate & testify!

MANY HAVE ASKED IF WE COULD WRITE MORE so the Family can catch more of what's happening here. Charran of Job was saying we must tell the world of how we do our Sunday Fellowships, as it's so inspiring. Well, our tremendous unity in Sunday Fellowship, which is so obvious to the visitor, must come from our plural marriage, the "One Wife" situation of the Spirit that we have here at Loveville, the result of having enough love to be trusted with enough liberty to live life to the full! PTL!

HERE'S A GENERAL FORMAT OF OUR SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP: The whole body gathers together in our large communal tent around 4 p.m. for a wonderful time of song—"Music of the Martyrs" (classics of the faith from past centuries), old time Family favourites such as Psalm 100, Psalm 121, "We've come this far by faith" etc. After a half-hour or so we're all inspired & ready for our memory review!

THE CHILDREN BOLDLY QUOTE THEIR NEW VERSES, Chapters, Daily Moments (adult & kids versions) intermixed with the adults who have Chapters & quotes to share as well. It's truly a Memory Revolution! There is no leniency or half-heartedness in this memory time. One point Faithy emphasized was the delivery of what you memorize! This sometimes lasts a half-hour.

THEN COMES TESTIMONY TIME!—A chance to share with all some of the exciting things the Lord has done in our different lives during the past week—the products of progress—whether it be the finishing of a radio show for the Int'l. MWM Show, the completion of a video, the writing of a new song or article,

or the winning of a soul on the local battlefield—all have their chance to share what the Lord is doing in their lives. What a Family, & what a variety of work to do for the Lord! Again, we emphasize to our children the importance of how they deliver their testimony & make sure they dwell on the parts that glorify Jesus, not emphasizing the pizza they provisioned but the love they gave to the one who donated it & how happy he was to give. It really spurs us to get our kids out to a park or school to win a soul, or to visit an orphanage, so we'll have real tales to tell of ones we've caught!

THEN IT IS TIME FOR THE WORD, the oil which truly keeps us united. For this we've been blessed to have fresh tapes from Dad with personal counsel to us on different subjects on quite a few Sundays. But even on other Sundays we still center around the Word for a real Sunday Fellowship, with good prayer!

FROM GOD in the prayer requests & quiet time that follows, & how convicting also, as He always shows us how we can do more. After Mo Letter & prayer, **WE HAVE A WONDERFUL COMMUNION** & sing more of the classics of the centuries while our "usher" Dizon or Patrick distributes the bread & passes the

wine. It's always inspiring to sing "Break Thou the Bread of Life" or Psalm 133 while the bread is being passed. (It usually takes a while as we have up to 100 people here for Sunday Fellowship) or while the wine is being passed to sing of the "Wonder Working Power of the Blood"—the only thing that can "Wash Away My Sins".

THEN FOLLOWS A GENERAL LOVE FEAST of hugging & kissing as we prepare ourselves for the Sunday soup or salad. After an hour or so of fellowship we then lead into a disco, a video or just a plain ol' Family inspiration time in which different ones sing—just a fun time. Usually by 11 p.m. or so most are heading for more intimate fellowship, which really keeps us not only one in Spirit but also one in flesh.

PTL FOR SUNDAY FELLOWSHIP! It's been providing quite a bit of spiritual strength & inspiration for all of us during the week that follows, as there is at times quite a workload, & Sunday is a way to get really restored! Thank God for Dad's wisdom in seeing the need for this!

I FORGOT TO MENTION HOW WE MAKE SURE THE MORNINGS ARE KEPT QUIET on Sunday, keeping the children with their respective families in the Word. This way we don't have a lot of children running around the camp who may disturb those trying to study & pray. We've also found it necessary to keep the children sitting with a parent or helper (or as close as possible) throughout our Fellowship Meeting, to keep them quiet & under control. They've been quite good at sitting quietly for these "long meetings" & have usually been a real sample, God bless them!
