FISHERMAN & CLUBS: Another major area of difference from the Letters and Tenerife method to the way we've seen the need to approach things from here is that:

GIRLS GOING TO A CLUB UN-ACCOMPANIED BY A MALE IS SIMPLY NOT DONE, very risky (civilization is not so genteel in affairs of sex east of Greece we've found!) and can get you a bad name fast, which makes catching big fish much more difficult! We've even found this held true in India to some extent! Going to clubs has borne relatively little fruit compared to making social contacts in more casual surroundings through mutual friends, business contacts and even hitchhiking!

FOLLOWING UP THESE FRIENDS AND LETTING THEM GRADUALLY FALL IN LOVE with our "respectable" sisters, and then revealing their willingness to share more deeply, seems to bear more fruit with less risk than going "all the way" after one, two or even a few dates. We feel this falls into the category of understanding local customs and taboos that you mentioned in "World Conquest Thru Love" just being in-tene with the mentality that we're trying to reach.

AS FAR AS FISHERMEN GO:

Though of course the fish hunger after the emotional and physical love through a woman, when you get down to changing their minds about matters of philosophy or religion or life's real values, Muslims <u>often</u> can receive these things better through the mouth of a <u>male</u> who is their close <u>friend</u>, than through a <u>woman</u> who is their

OFTEN WE FIND OURSELVES SPENDING A LONG LONG TIME ON SOMEONE WHO ISN'T EVEN SAVED or at least doesn't understand salvation very clearly, and having to devote the major amount of a bait's time to one fish—as they are either kings or potential kings—and non-Christians, especially Muslims, can take a while to bring to Jesusl WE DRAW ENCOURAGEMENT

WE DRAW ENCOURAGEMENT FROM LETTERS LIKE "MISSION-ARY'S PRAYER" AND "MO MEETS MO'AMMER" AND THE ISLAM LETTERS, as well as the examples in the Bible of Esther, Ruth and even Abraham and Sara. But, this can really limit your stats, unless these Homes feel understood, it can even drive them to a hasty, or

tactics in <u>Teheran</u>! A little word of understanding of these circumstances in a Letter would help a lot!

I FIND MYSELF OFTEN IN THE UNCOMFORTABLE POSITION OF SAYING I DON'T THINK DAD EXPECTS US TO DO THAT HERE! Most agree, but if it's in a Letter, it would be a big help! "Quality, not Quantity" is really the keynote for drop-in, Third-Wrold FF'ing, we feel! An indiscretion, or a tangled line can result in big problems; again, not just for us, but also our fish! Most of these fields make Spain (which inspired "Don't Drop Out—Drop-in") look like a totally free society! (DAD: Amen!)

BUSINESSES: One last subject that we've been knocking around with a lot of the brothers in these countries is the potential (and advantages!) of starting small family-controlled businesses, which often could provide the covers, visas and income that jobs do, without having the quenching effects of working under ungodly taskmasters of system employers.

in India who wanted to see us do something efficiently before giving us a bigger slice of his kingdom, which could be considerable!

EVEN IN THE MIDEAST, WE COULD MARKET HANDICRAFTS, act as agents for entertainment, etc. quite easily! Or even open healthfood restaurants and stores, etc. Actually, several brothers are taking steps in these directions. God help us, we don't want to get like the Jews, using God's Family for business purposes, but we see how business ventures, even not strictly message-oriented, could be more conducive to ministering than jobs in certain circumstances.

YET, IT'S SO <u>DIFFERENT</u>
FROM OUR OLD WAY of doing things we'd really appreciate a little word from you on it, if possible. We're not trying to turn the house of prayer into a house of merchandise, but rather the house of merchandise into a house of prayer, if you know what we mean. And out here, in the oil boom states at least, the whole place is a house of merchandise! Sound feasible? /DAD: Why not?—"All to the Glory of Cod!" 1 Co. 10:31.1

IN DUBAI AND TEHERAN, the most developed of our drop-in works so far, we've seen some incredibly good fruit, and tremendous potential! Even using the very gradual, dropped-in approach, these areas have at least as many, if not more, good fish and friends on the line per labourer, as the works we've seen in freer areas.

SEPARATIONS AND SCATTERED CHILDREN!

A problem that seems to be occurring very much recently is a flippant attitude about separating, finding new loves, etc., even in established families with two, three and four children. The parents separate, divide the children and take off! Soon they get discouraged because they can't find people to take on the responsibility of the children with them and they say, "What's

wrong with these single brethren, where's the Letter 'One Wife'?"
But if they themselves have shown an irresponsible attitude towards their young ones, it is hard to inspire someone else to take on the responsibility!
