## You <u>Can</u> Make Bread On A Campfire!

STEAMED BREAD

Ingredients: 1 cup whole wheat flour, 1 slightly rounded teaspoon baking powder, ½ teaspoon baking powder, ½ teaspoon sait, 2 tablespoons vegetable oil, ½ cup water. Mix dry ingredients & oil, then stir in water. Batter should be fairly loose, like drop-biscuit dough. How to cook: Spoon batter into heavily greased 1 lb. coffee can. Put on plastic lid & poke a few small holes in lid with knife (for expansion of gases). Piece can upright in large pot with cover. Add a few inches of water & boil for 45 min. to 1 hr. until done when knife blade stuck in center of loaf comes out clean. When done shake can to loosen bread, turn upside down & shake it out.

BAKED ON A STONE

(From "Campfire Cookbook" by Verily Anderson.) A bake stone is any large flat slab of

stone (except flint, which might explode & splinter). You can heat it above the fire or put it right into the embers & leave it there for half an hour. Take it out (between 2 strong sticks) & you can bake on it for another half hour. Do this a little way away so that other things can be cooked on the fire. Be careful to keep it away from grass or plants that it may singe or kill. If you grease it, you can fry an egg on it!

Here's a simple biscuit recipe
the book gives: Flat Bannocks
Ingredients: 2 mugfuls self-rising flour (substitute wholewheat
flour & 2 teaspoons baking powder), ½ mugful of water, 1 teaspoon salt. Mix water, alt &
flour with hands to a stiff dough.
Press dough lightly into a ball.
Put on flattened flour bag &
press lightly with backs of hands
to flatten. Cook on hot bake
stone for about 20 minutes.

**FUEL SAVER** 

FUEL SAVER
Hera's a super-quick, easy & versatile "bread" used by the Mexicans & Indians for centuries:
In Mexico it's called a flour tortilla, in India it's a chapate.
Ingredients to make 1 doz. large tortillas: 2 cups whode wheat flour, 1 tsp. salt, 1 tsp. baking powder, 1 tablespoon margarine, % cup water (approx.) Thoroughly mix dry ingredients. Cut in margarine & add enough water to make a stiff dough. Divide into egg-sized balls. Roll each ball out on a lightly floured board into shape of a circle, as thin as possible (about 5-8 in. in diameter). "Bake" about 20-30 seconds on each side on ungreased fry pan over medium heat, or use bake stone or griddle. If you bake too long they come out brittle but if not overdone they are soft & flexible. For breakfast try rolling up your scrambled egg in it. For lunch spread it with peanut butter & honey. At supper mop up your stew, chill or curry with it. honey. At supper mop up stew, chili or carry with it.
