for dinner, & we do our weekly
shopping & provisioning together. One of the couples serves as
our Shepherds & Servants-ofAll, & we regularly share our battles & victories with them.

WE MUST BE SOME SORT
OF OLD-FASHIONED BLOB
bursting at the seams in one overcrowded & uncomfortable
dwelling, right? Some classical
remnant from days gone by, a
nostalgic trip into the Family's
past when our colonies were
more densely populated than
Singspore? Wrong! Thank God!
WE'RE LIVING IN A TRAILER CAMP, our 3 trailers & 3
individual tents placed in a circle bound by trees & shrubbery
& overlooking a blue sea that
feeds a small crescent beach just
a short walk away. We're loving
every minute of it & the Lord
has amply rewarded our faith in
this latest turn of the Revolution.

OUR CAMPGROUND IS ONLY 32 KM. FROM AN IMPORTANT SOUTHERN EUROPEAN CAPITAL. Its owner, who
also lives here in a house with
his wife & 4 daughters, is quite
visibly happy that we are here
& shows it by giving us lowseason rates during the high season, allowing us to hook up our
communal washing machine to
his own water source, placing a
separate bathroom & shower at
our exclusive disposal, giving us occasional gifts & invitting us all
to his house for Saturday-night
parties, during which our children have sung & done skits,

I THE EASE & EFFICIENCY

OF OUR DAILY LIFE could hardly be matched by the same number of people living in, say, the same urban block. What comes naturally here in our green setting would be cumbersome, unwieldy or imposible in a concrete jungle.

I'LL GIVE YOU A FEW EX-nameles. One family of 5, with its car & trailer, pays only the equivalent of \$150 a month to live at the campgrounds, & for that price they have full, unlimited use of its utilities & facilities. WE ARE WITHIN SIGHT & WITHIN A FEW STEPS FROM ALL OTHERS IN OUR CAMP, thus ensuring fellowship & mutual assistance when the need arises (& it does arise with 13 kidsl). Altho' some of us have our own emergency-use portable toilets, we normally utilise the camp's own string of about a dozen indoor stalls with wash basins, & at shower time there are more than 10 awaiting without delay. than 10 awaiting without delay.
HOT WATER IS AVAILABLE

FOR DISHES all day long. The campground has a mini-market for all the basics (plus some very reasonably-priced cooked meals); there are 2 telephones with direct dialing practically all over the world; the nearest town is but a 12-minute walk away & offers every conceivable service, including relaxing & cheap seaside cafes & bus service to the capital every 45 minutes.

DIFFERENT TEAMS OF 2 TAKE TURNS EVERY EVEN. ING AT THE KITCHEN, which sits under an outdoor tent a few feet from the long dining table that is normally set outside to take advantage of the late afternoon breeze & is protected from the sun by a huge liliac canopy recently presented to us by our landlord, GBHI

MEALS VARY ACCORDING TO WHAT'S AVAILABLE & PROVISIONED, of course, & to the time available for cooking. But we have 3 or 4 imaginative cooks amongst us, so we're assured weekly of at least that many really finger-licking-good dinners. Even some of the leginners, like myself, will attempt something up-beat once in a while with the help of our more gifted cooks.

DISHMASHING FOR 25 RECENTLY SHIFTED FROM BEING JUST AN ACCEPTED DUTY to a welcome thrill, thanks to the children. Last week, when a new cooking & dishwashing schedule went up, some of the children suggested (& got thru'!) that the phrase "and sharing" be added to the solitary "dishwashing". So now every evening there is the possibility of more love being spread even more widely. And heeding "Child Brides" our 2 youngest adults are partaking of the late

evening intimacy.

A good portion of our fruit & vegetables & a supply of lamb is usually provisioned, thus cutting our average weekly cost of dinner food & beverages to about \$5-6 per person.

WE WILL UNDOUBTEDLY SOON HAVE TO "PACK M UP & MOVE"M OUT" TO SOUTH -AMERICA, & we have learned some invaluable lessons about camping which will come in handy down there where life-on-wheels is not as commonplece. Chiefly, we have come to appreciate even more the strength, comfort & protection that the Family gives, & how large numbers of us could conceivably camp together without sacrificing elbow room, feeling like sardines or blowing our security.

IN FACT, AS CAMPING IN S. AMERICA, it may be ill-advised to pitch camp on your own. Besides all the benefits of sharing & fellowship, you'd miss out on the possibility of establishing a floating Family community which only camping affords.

An average campground will have over 100 people at one time. Besides the possible witnessing opportunities that this presents & which you could take up prayerfully depending on each situation, this also means that every so often one of those people, for personal real-sons, may need to quickly sell his tent &/or trailer.

CAMPGROUND RECEPTION DESKS THUS BECOME IM-PORTANT PLACES for anyone looking to sell or buy used tents or trailers. Let them know, even if you're not staying there, that you are looking for one. You can sometimes find real bargains. We recently did, for another couple that needed one.

I REALLY HOPE & PRAY THAT MORE OF OUR FAMILY ARE TAKING POSITIVE STEP'S toward becoming mobile, Like any new radical step in life, the fear of the unknown sometimes defeats us. If we remember that the Lord's leading this way & that the Letters are showing the way, we will soon take that all-important first step. Try it! I'll change your life!

## **Coming To Australia?**

Official gov't. requirements for residency & how to get it!

WE'RE NOT SUGGESTING THAT AUSTRALIA NEEDS MORE FAMILY IMMIGRANTS as pioneer fields like South America obviously need labourers far more & will probably be more fruitful in souls won. We write this for those trying to leave the Northern Hemisphere who aren't ready for pioneer fields & are more called to litness & witness part-time, & to work, earn money & to support needy brethren in pioneer fields. Australia is probably the country most like America, & its refuges will probably be safe in the coming war, Lord willing THE AUSTRALIAN DEPT. OF IMMIGRATIONS HAS ADOPTED CERTAIN GUIDE. LINES controlling the entry of immigrants. They state that there is no prejudice as to colour, religion, country of birth, against any applicants. However, the selection criteria ensures that—ONLY RESPECTABLE & FINANCIALLY SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS ARE LIKELY TO RECEIVE PERMANENT STATUS. They don't want an influx of those likely to need welfare or special medical care (i.e. no bums & hippies, & you'd better look like a systemitel). ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE IS DETERMINED BY A TEST in which

for residency & how to get it!

the applicant scores points for various skills, assets, health or circumstance. If you score more than a certain number of points, you are allowed permanent resident status, & if you don't score the required number of points you can't come.

THE TEST EXAMINES MATTERS SUCH AS: Trade skills or profession (vocational training), native language (the ability to speak & read English is desirable), financial assets which one is able to bring to Australia, health (you & your dependents having good health is desirable), & other issues. For example, the applicant may score points for having skill as a typist, nurse, specialist teacher, welder or carpenter. He may also score points for having a large number of children (sad to say!).

SOME ISSUES FIGURE VERY HIGH! Y ON THIS POINTS

SOME ISSUES FIGURE VERY HIGHLY ON THIS POINTS SCALE. One is that it is most SCALE. One is that it is most important for the prospective immigrant to have a job waiting for him in Australia (even pumping petrol will do if you have no other skills or trade). The prospective immigrant must undertake that he will not apply for unemployment benefits while in Australia (at least not for 3 years, until he is naturalised as an Australian citizen).

THE AUSTRALIAN OFFERING THE JOB IS REQUIRED

ING THE JOB IS REQUIRED TO GUARANTEE FINANCIAL TO GUARANTEE FINANCIAL SUPPORT for the immigrant. Obviously there must be a great deal of trust between the immigrant as sponsor, because the Australian sponsor risks finding himself in serious trouble should the immigrant misbehave! As well, the sponsor would be unable to sponsor any future Famana and the sponsor an

ily immigrants, so it is a very serious matter.
THIS METHOD OF OBTAIN-ING PERMANENT RESIDENCE WORKS WELL IF THE IMMIGRANT HAS NO FUNDS of GHANT HAS NO FUNDS of his own but has a trusted friend in Australia who will guarantee his support. The authorities will not accept that the sponsor "lives by faith". Our Yugoslav friends who run small businesses sponsor their relatives, guaran-teeing them a job on arrival in

sponding them a job on arrival in Australia.

ANOTHER ALTERNATIVE IS TO HAVE SUFFICIENT CAPITAL TO START A SUCCESSFUL BUSINESS in Australia & to support yourself from the profits. (Until you get naturalised, taxation & immigration officials will be watching you to see if you are running the successful business you claimed you would. Citizenship after 3 years is not granted automatically. They could send you home if you failed to make a profit.)

FAMILY MEMBERS COULD POOL FUNDS, or God may bless somebody with a large inheritance. Alternatively, Family members with wealthy parents or Fish or kings, might persuade them to invest in Australia. Many worldly businessmen, especially Americans, are aware of the coming War & consider Australia to be the best place in the world to invest large sums of money. The Family immigrants could manage the business out here on behalf of their wealthy parents, Fish or kings.

ONE CAN BUY A BUSINESS LIKE A BISTRO for about \$20-30,000. Running a bistro doesn't involve your having a great deal of skill as a chef, unlike a restaurant. There would be a lot of hard work, but it could be a good place for witnessing (singing, Fring).

ANOTHER ENTERPRISE

MORE SUITED TO THE COMING CRASH would be to purchase a farm & become a primary producer (i.e. set up a refuge). However, one needs a minimum of \$50,000 to purchase &
develop a property to an incomeproducing condition.

SO, THE PERSON WITH NO
MONEY, SKILLS OR WAITING
JOB IS UNLIKELY TO BE
GRANTED PERMANENT RESIDENCE, unless of course, they
marry an Australian. What can
one do? One could start to acquire skills which are assessed
by performance rather than education, perhaps by taking a
short-duration "hobby" course
at a technical college. Examples
include typist, welder, draftsman.
(I built up an architectural drafting business with no qualifications as a draftsman.) Most
trade skills (e.g. carpenter) are
assessed by completion of a 4year apprenticeship, & are thus
not suitable.

ONE WOULD THEN HAVE
TO FIND SOMEONE IN AUSTRALIA TO EMPLOY HIM.
Few Family members have businesses, & no businessmen will
employ someone they don't
know. Perhaps Australian Family members should make a special effort to get more businessmen turned on to the Family (&
Jesus!), so that they will want
to soonsor immigrants.

get you into Australia permanently. You could work in your promised job awhile & gradually get into witnessing in a self-supporting fashion.

HOWEVER, WHEN YOU AP-PLY FOR CITIZENSHIP 3 yrs. later, the authorities will want to know how you have supported yourself, so it is advisable to have proof of having held a part-time job, or having been self-employed in a small-scale business that paid taxes, even if you were spending, a lot of your time witnessing.

FF'ERS COULD WORK FOR ESCORT AGENCIES, for example. We would hate to see anyone sliding into the system away of from serving the Lord & witness ing. Citizenship is desirable, or else the poor immigrant will be counted as an alien, at a great disadvantage if rationing should be introduced.

NOTE: IT IS IMPOSSIBLE(I) TO BE GRANTED PERMAN-ENT RESIDENCE WHILST ONE IS IN AUSTRALIA ON A VISITOR'S VISAI By applying, you risk getting yourself deported whilst a tourist! You are granted permission to visit Australia only by undertaking that you will definitely go back.

ONE MUST MAKE APPLICATION FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE FROM YOUR NATIVE COUNTRY. You do score a few points for having previously visited Australia as a tourist. A wise thing to do

might be to come out here on a visitor's visa & use the time to try to line up a definite job offer, or several offers, even working for your prospective sponsor for a while in the hope of impressing them. Male or female FF'ers should spend their tourist time FF'ing business persons like mad! Pray hard for the Lord to lead you to the right ones!

BUT YOU WILL STILL HAVE TO RETURN TO YOUR NATIVE LAND & apply for permanent residence from there, with proof of a definite job offer accompanying your application & tipping the points assess ment in your favour. An intention to invest capital in Australia, saying that you intend to later run your own business after you have worked awhile, would probably win the system's heart too.

"BE WISE AS SERPENTS & HARMLESS AS DOVES!" It is not impossible for Family members to get permanent residence in Australia. However they do need vision, drive, enthusiasm, anitiative, prayer, "shtick", & knowing that they are in God's Will! P.S. An interesting Biblical parallel is found in Acts: Paul's Roman citizenship sure got him out of a lot of scrapes, & gave him lots of free:
