For instance, we were very surprised while travelling in different provinces in fairly large towns & small cities that eating dogs among some people is common (especially while drinking) & thinking nothing of it. They sell it quite openly in some restaurants. We know that here in the capital the poor eat dog also as things are getting more expensive & scarce, little by little. So we want to warn some brethren in some witnessing areas that some restaurants might be tempted to use dog meat in the hamburgers to save money. A lot of these hamburgers are already made up of pork anyway. Ever since we saw this while travelling outside the city we prefer to stick to fish & chicken to be sure. GBY! "KEEP A CLOSE EYE ON DRIED SURVIVAL FOODS during wet & cold months, as we have lost our store of soybeans because of damp atmosphere." —John & Fathly; British Isles.

"WE'VE FOUND A CHEAP & EFFECTIVE FORM OF INSULATION for our caravan which can be obtained from any builders' supply. Expanded polystyrene sheets can be stuck to the bottom of your caravan & will keep in the heat & keep out cold & damp. A one-inch layer is sufficient." —Ben, Joan & Ruth; Br. Isles.
