Late Video News! -New Video Accessories on the Market! Buying Tips from Thaddeus, W.S. Researcher

Thaddeus, W.S. Researcher:
WHILE AT THE VIDEO FAIR
we noticed that there were a
great number of pre-recorded
films from the dark side of the
spirit world—horror, violence,
porn & the worst of society's
traits were the major themes.
Good films were very few & far
between. Since in general it is
only the rich who can afford
these tapes, it is clear who they
are out to subvert & distract from
the real world. The worst excesses of American society—whether
real or imaginary—were predominant, & I would say that there
are few films on the market we
could recommend. Exceptions
were the Biblical epics, including
the 4-part "Jesus of Nazareth".
WHILST THE BIG COMPANIES ARE MAKING LITTLE ATTEMPT TO IMPROVE THE DOMESTIC FORMATS so that they
can be used by professionals to

<u>CAMERAS</u> ARE IMPROVING FASTER THAN ANY OTHER ASPECT of the video market at the moment, & mass production combined with the extensive use of new technology & "chips" is bringing their price down dramatically. This was a point brought out at the seminar at the end:
The video field is advancing so rapidly that things unheard of a

few years ago are now on the market, so the business of pre

few years ago are now on the market, so the business of predicting future prices & value-formoney was a very difficult one.

JVC ASSURED US THAT THE VHS FORMAT WILL BE AROUND FOR SEVERAL YEARS to come. But there are new machines coming: In a year to 3 years there will be a complete recording system in a unit the size of a cine camera, which is the market they are obviously aiming to take over.

THE VHS SYSTEM HAS BY NO MEANS REACHED THE LIMITS OF ITS DEVELOPMENT. Whilst the new JVC 7700 is probably the ultimate in its facilities (almost), they expect new advances in ancilliary equipment—particularly in the area of editing & maintaining quality. No high-speed duplicator is on the market yet, but as the demand is building for one, it could appear at next year's show.

VIDEO DISCS are being intro-

VIDEO DISCS are being introduced this year, & like their audio counterparts they will only be available in a pre-recorded form. They are somewhat similar in appearance to audio discs, but there the similarity ends. Again, there are several different formats, none of which will clearly have predominance, & none of the discs of one format will fit another's machine.

COSTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE LOWER THAN FOR TAPE RECORDERS, approx. 1,000

Swiss Francs being a figure quoted. They will produce high quality pictures up to an hour in
length on each side of the disc,
with hi-fi sound quality, probably in stereo. Features will include permanent pause, slowmotion, variable speed & random
search facilities.
ONE REVOLUTIONARY ASPECT OF THIS DISC will be its
ability to store up to about 500

thousand pages of material on one side of a disc! For this type of educational material, total playing time will be reduced to 35 minutes per side. It will be possible to get our own material put on record but, as with audio discs, it will be very expensive & only viable with a run of over 2,000. For instance, to give you an idea of the capacity of these discs, the Encyclopedia Britannica could be put on one disc. What about the Letters?

THEY ARE EXPECTING VIDEO DISCS TO TAKE UFF quite fast, with discs being available at about 60 SF a time & sales of 1% of the video market in about 2 years. The effect on the tape market is likely to be a virtual end of the pre-recorded tapes, since the discs will be less than half their price.

deal since the quality of the video discs will be way above present discs, altho' some manufacturers are coming out with similar
types of audio discs. The new

IN THE VIDEO CASSETTE MARKET THERE IS NOW LIKELY TO BE A RUSH TO MINIATURISATION & COST REDUCTION, & nowhere more so than in the camera field. Micro-chip technology & mass-production should all but wipe out the Super-8 market as the cost of equipment falls drastically. VHS is still likely to last a long while, but with further miniaturisation of the recorder.

IT IS VERY LIKELY THAT A COMBINED CAMERA-RE-CORDER WILL BE INTRODUC

CORDER WILL BE INTRODUC-ED quite shortly, maybe in a couple of years at the most, using a very small cassette which can then be edited onto a larger &

THE BASIC VHS WILL CHANGE MUCH, but there will be some continued refinements. Interfaces between it & the U-matic system are just around the corner, & editing is likely to improve still further. Quality of reproduction is unlikely to improve greatly, but better camera technology will help. Sound is likely to be improved. Already the National Panasonic Industrial Machine has stereo sound, & that trend is likely to continue.


ANOTHER DEVELOPMEN' IS SATELLITE BROADCASTING.—Already available now in the States & soon in Europe.

Facsimile transmissions are now possible over the phone, as is the transmission of all types of data. This could make the typewriter as we know it today obsolete in a matter of a couple of years.

This means that we can get our picture well, but without costly adjustments we can't get sound. What we've done tho', is to set up a small amplifier & speaker

WHEN VIDEOING, THE
SOUND IS A PERENNIAL
PROBLEM. The best way to
overcome this is to have an extra
person to handle it as the mike
on the camera is usually too far
from the subject, so the input
signal is low. Copies are particularly affected.

A SMALL PORTABLE
SOUND STUDIO—a mixer, some
good mikes of different types
(but matching) & some good
quality cabies & pluga—can transform a medicore film into a good
one, since the ear is so much
more sensitive to distortions
than the eye. We seem to be
able to tolerate poor video, but
we really notice poor sound.

The new machines have "Dolby" on them which helps, but their very design—using a relatively slow speed—is a quality inhibiting factor. When there is one weak link in the chain it is essential to make all the other links as strong as possible to prevent any further losses.

ANOTHER LITTLE TIP WE LEARNED is that most video machine breakdowns are caused by mechanical breakdowns, the majority of them by human error, rough treatment or incorrect handling. We were just a really rare exception this month. If treated gently these machines should last very well. But put a tape in the wrong way 'round, then I pray it's a rented machine since the cost of repair is enormous! Since they are usually put under the TV, children must be kept away.

MAILING CASES FOR TAPES ARE NOT YET AVAILABLE at a good price with good security. Perhaps we could use reinforced envelopes in future which could be re-used. This would save a great deal of time, especially considering the number of people sending tapes after the ministry takes off. The last tape sent to us in the mail arrived fine with no problems, some 4 days after mailing.
