Two extra hours of lilming were provisioned on a large island ferry boat at a nearby port, the Lord providing strong winds that night to complete the storm scena.

COSTUMES WERE PROVIDED BY OUR FAITHFUL PROVISIONING TEAM of Rose Mideast, Daniel, & John & Daniela—a captain's uniform for Simon (a perfect fit!), & seven pairs of trousers & seven hats for the chief officers! Spyros, a clothing shop owner & tithing friend of the Family, donated ten adult & ten children's tshirts stamped with "HMS MWM" on the front, with blue sailor hats for the boys, & the girls with their white hats & bikinis, the costumes were complete!

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EIGHT NEW INSPIRED SONGS WERE WRITTEN & RECORDED FOR THE SHOW! Simon was busy on the script & Topaz with the choreography. A full dress rehearsal brought everyone together for the finishing touches & then it was off to bed for an early reveille—5:00 a.m.
