But be sure to counsel with upperlevel leaders" (loosely paraphrased). So the overall effect, although their words said to FF, was to stifle

a real FF push.

They were at least trying, but I don't think they saw the adverse effect their "spiritual" view of FF'ing and going to clubs had. Here, the single girls and the girls without their mates make the initial strike and really go after them, and in an hour or two make more effect than we were making after three or four nights! Fisherwomen—what a bomb that's going to be!

Jeth had a meeting and told 20 people that their heads were in their pants and bawled them out (as I mentioned previously). Deb had an FF meeting and gave testimonies, but again made it all sound so spiri-tual that I think some wanted to avoid it for fear of not being spiritual enough.

Personally, I believe most of our girls would do best just to be their own natural selves, concerned for

each sheep that they meet. Rather than trying to work up the Spirit, they should just show them genuine love and a little bit of physical concern before putting out a big "spiritual love" rap, if you know what I mean! Deb tried to talk about things relating to the Spirit, and did well at this. But the flesh seemed just a tiny bit too removed.

To explain how it lacked that certain intimacy with fish that I've seen here, Isaiah announced in the big here, isalan amounted in the old by FF meeting: "Maybe the girls shouldn't do FF leports, but rather the fisherman should report on each fish." In other words, the girls weren't trusted with getting intimate with the men first, without the fish-erman butting in. So the girls need to be given more leeway, more line.

Praise the Lord! I love you and love being here. We're learning so much, it's truly a great blessing to us. We have so much to learn and are thankful for the sample here!

Much love, Shaul & Abiah "Ready to go, ready to stay, ready the need to fill" and can see the Lord's hand in these latest changes.

I know myself, that I have an awful lot to learn still and have not had the very important experience of working right there in the field, learning of the problems, under-standing the difficulties, going through the trials out there, and of course enjoying the wonderful victories that God always gives!

I know we are all "on the front lines", or at least should be, but when you are actually out there, it is somewhat different. I am really looking forward to it as a great challenge, and by His grace we'll be able to meet it! Both Bec and I really love you, and I pray that in our time in WS we have not displeased the Lord. PTL! There are so many things as I look back that could have been done, Lord help me and forgive me! I hope to re-main close to you in the Spirit!

I love you and can never thank you enough for what you have all done for me. Your patience and love have really stunned me so many times when I let you down, but I know God can use me. God has given you a measure of love that I never thought possible in a mortal body. I have seen you in action and have felt your spirit working, and this keeps me warm and close to you. Dearest David, I love you very much!

I was reading through the "King Arthur" series again, and so many times I re-lived the situations in minute detail that have been so faithfully chronicled by you and

your beautiful girls in the Letters. I re-lived again the frustration and fears that were so much a part of my miserable lonely life, and are still a part of so many lonely souls still out there in that Godless world.

It makes me weep when I think of the way you gave your all to me, you gave your wife and your lover, Jesus, to me, and I can never find words to thank you. But by His Grace I will live my thanks to Him and you each day in our new life. Hallelujah!

Dear David and Maria, it's funny, but being away from you for so long now, I feel closer to you in the Spirit. I feel your sample and your spirit living in me and it makes me so very happy! I have changed so much in my four years in the Family, and I feel an even greater responsibility has been placed on us now, in carrying the spirit of David out to our new field, and we ask for your prayers.

You have given us such a heavy vision for loving the world! Your vision for Nationalisation is really going to pay off. Bec was telling me how Faithy always used to go straight to the Nationals and start training them right away to reach their own country with their own language and personal testimony. God bless Faithy and Rachel and all the other obedient servants. Without you and your words we are just lost sheep. There are so many more to bring into His loving arms. Let's go! Hallelujah! 
