Heavenly Home Helpers: Laundry Tips!

WASH BLUE JEANS INSIDE-OUT, especially new ones, to prevent white lines from showing up. Wash new clothing items, espeically blue jeans, separately so the colour doesn't run onto other clothes. If you plan to wash and shrink a pair of new leans, try adding a pair of faded old jeans to "dye" them "back to denim" as the new jeans give off colour in the wash.

TO REMOVE BLOOD STAINS, wash the garment out immediately in cold, not warm or hot (as it will set the stain) water. Then rub a piece of lemon on the dry garment and dry in the sun (this is for a white or colour-fast item). Then wash as usual, and the stain should be completely gone!

TO REMOVE INK STAINS from ball point pen, spray hair-spray directly on the dry garment, let it dry and wash the ink out.

BEDDING: For young babies who drool, it is important to keep clean, dry sheets on their beds. Babies can contract rashes just from sleeping on soiled, damp sheets. To save on sheets, try outting an absorbent cloth "puddle under baby's head while sleeping, such as a flannel receiving

blanket. Be sure it is big enough to tuck it in securely on both sides so as not to twist or roll over the baby and possibly smother him. Change it twice a day or as necessary to keep it clean and dry under baby's face and head.

AIR CHILDREN'S MATTRESS-ES AND PILLOWS in the sun and fresh air frequently, especially when being potty-trained. It's nice to occasionally spray the mattress with some sort of disinfectant spray. -You can make your own by following the diluting directions on the bottle of disinfectant and sprinkling the solution on the mattress and airing it out. Of course, always use a mattress pad! If the child's blanket gets pee-pee on it, you can imme-diately spot wash it and hang it out to dry, unless it is totally dirty and requires a full wash.

TOWELS: The quickest way to ruin a good towel is to throw it in the laundry bin while it is still damp or wet!-Not only will the towel mildew, but it will cause the other laundry to mildew too! Also always hang up towels singly to dry after use, over a radiator or in the fresh if possible.

OCCASIONALLY, WASH A LOAD OF TOWELS IN VERY HOT WATER to give them a good, thorough wash. However, it's not usually necessary to use hot or even warm water for general laundry, unless the items are very dirty.
YOU KNOW WHAT GRAND-

ing the dishes, she would fill the sink with very, very hot water and wash the dish towels and cloths right there and then hang them up to dry so they would be ready to use for the next meal!

DRYING DISHES WITH A DISH TOWEL CAN BE VERY UNSANI-TARY if the towels are not kept clean or washed well. Dad usually recommends letting the dishes dry by themselves in the dishrack. If you use hot water, especially for the rinse, the dishes won't take too long

to dry.
DON'T USE YOUR NICE DISH TOWELS FOR WIPING UP SPILLS on the counters or floors, as potholders, or for any other purpose than what they're meant to be used for-or they'll become heavily stained and smelly, too!
HANGING UP HINT: A time-

saver is to hang on the clothesline in a row the same type of items of washing, such as all the dish towels together, all the socks together, etc. That way, when you're removing and folding things, your sorting job is half done!

> CARE OF KIDS' CLOTHES

by Beraja; teacher in Italy CHILDREN SHOULD NEVER WEAR ANYTHING THAT HAS HOLES IN IT! I ask our children to bring and show me any of their clothes that need repair, or the button that just fell off, etc.-and they do!-Because they know I don't like them to wear damaged clothes. So now they get concerned

CLOTHES SHOULD NEVER BE FULL OF WRINKLES, but ironed if needed. Many times hanging up clothes just after they've dried prevents having to iron them.

WHEN A NICE ITEM OF CLOTH-ING GETS STAINED by accident and there is no way to remove the stain, we dye it another colour (a package of dye is very inexpensive) instead of throwing the clothing

I REALLY LIKE THE LITTLE INITIAL TAGS you can buy in the sewing department of almost any big store. They are made in strips, which you can cut out and sew on the inside of each piece of clothing. Mothers may prefer to sew their own initial on their children's clothing, so they can be passed down within the same family or returned to the mother.

WHEN A CHILD TEARS A HOLE in the knee of his long pants, you can either sew a nice little patch on each knee or use matching iron-on patches and turn them into play pants. You can also cut them off to make summer shorts. The same goes for long-sleeved shirts.

I BELIEVE CHILDREN CAN LEARN TO BE CLEAN, orderly, and tidy by the way we dress them and keep their <u>surroundings</u>. So, I believe it's very important to take good care of our children's clothing, and the Lord will bless us with what they need! You may not be able to afford <u>new</u> clothes, but you can't afford not to keep 'em clean, ironed & in good repair so the kids will be a good sample!

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
