News & Tips from Campers & Caravaners Around the World!

"ROOKY RULES" FOR CAMPERS!

From Micah & Joanne Teddy Bear:

THESE ARE SOME LESSONS WE LEARNED as we camped & travelled during the summer "Europe One" music tour with Jeane Manson:

A CAMPING GUIDE published here in France by Michelin we found to be very helpful. It gives all vital info on every campground, area or farm equipped for campers in France telling exactly what services are available, when open, price, no. of campsites, telephone no. to make reservations, even a star rating like hotels!

HERE IN FRANCE IN SUMMER THERE'S "FARM CAMPING" in which a farmer opens his land to campers. The advantages are that it's more private & quiet & you can buy farm fresh eggs, milk, cheese etc. at very low prices. The disadvantages are that sometimes facilities such as showers etc. are less than at organised campgrounds. We found it good for witnessing tho', as they're more personal & people seem more drawn to talk & share, especially during the "campers morning coffee ritual".

IF YOU'RE A SINGER OR MUSICIAN, camping will give you an ideal chance for good witnessing & provisioning &

free camping if you offer to put on a "show".

TIPS ON TENT CAMPING:

We found it good to lay a tarp or sheet of plastic down first, then pitch your tent (even if it has its own floor), for an additional layer of insulation & protection. Just make sure that the tent itself goes out beyond the area of the under-tarp; otherwise you create a

ready-made rain-catch guaranteed to wash you out! (Cost: Experience!)

IF YOU PITCH YOUR TENT ON THE BEACH or other windy area, you'll need a wind-break: Park your vehicle right in front of your tent (which you have pitched back end facing the wind!) so that the vehicle is between your tent & the wind. Or ano-

ther wind-break is to use nearby trees or poles or extra tent poles & a tarp to create an airfoil by making a lean-to between you & the wind with the high end at the top back end of your tent. This will cause the wind to sweep over you without putting any pressure on your tent.

WE FOUND IT WISE TO FILL UP OUR WATER CONTAINERS before breaking camp & going on to the next & travel with full water capacity. You can never be certain of conditions where you're headed!

MAKE GOOD USE OF LAUNDROMATS whenever you pass one! In France, at

least, they are quite scarce & you may not find one in every town!

THERE WAS ONE PROBLEM WE NEVER FOUND A SOLUTION FOR: Bees & wasps! Perhaps it's just because we were leary of putting chemical bug repellents all over us all summer but we never did get rid of this pesky problem! Anybody got a solution? Love, Micah & Joanne. (Later: Tips on camping with children—by Joanne.)

ON JEANE MANSON: "She has seemed more open than ever. She has continued to have group prayer with all the mem-
