OUR BIGGEST PROBLEM
HAS BEEN THE RAIN coming in the tent, with heavy storms. I had to dig holes & drive the pegs deeper into the

ground & also dig a good trench all around, & we eve moved to a flatter surface. SOME INTERESTING CAMPING GEAR I'VE NO TICED which seem good ideas are: a car with a tent that opens onto a roof rack & is reached by a ladder, so you sleep on top of your car! Also backpacks with a little seat built into the frame, inflatable coat hangers, & locks for the tent (only usable for tents with built-in ground sheets).

GOING OVERLAND TO THE ORIENT, before we got out of Europe, my favourite quick one-pot meal was this: Hamburger meat sauteed in our only pot & when it was cooked I'd mix in one very large can of lentils & one can large can of lentils & one can of mixed vegetables that I'd buy at a passing supermarket. Use juices from the can & you've got a hot, cheap, nutritious meal, really good for cold winter nights. It may not sound so good but as they say "hunger makes the best sauce" hal (Colk hemburger well). -ha! (Cook hamburger well!)
ONCE OUT OF EUROPE,

we hadn't stocked up on Euro

pean canned goods but simply bought what we considered safe & cheap in each country goat cheeses, flat Persian bread, olives, curd, boiled egg (you can pay someone to boil them for you), & all sorts of fruits & vegetables. Just remember the golden rule for raw produce out here—if you can't peel it, don't eat it!
WE'D USUALLY STOP

FOR ONE MEAL A DAY at a native restaurant, usually some sort of meat & rice dish & maybe a cooked vegetable. We never drank the water tho but ordered tea & drank it out of our own cups & often used our own forks & spoons tool Nobody minds, as we foreigners are a pretty odd bunch anyway. Hal WATER PURIFICATION:

When coming overland by car we had a huge water container in the back with purified water in it. Purification tablets come in various strengths. Some are meant for large containers & some for a liter or so, so read directions carefully before adding to your little canteen or 5-gallon jug!

I KNOW SO MANY OF THESE THINGS HAVE BEEN SAID BEFORE, but it is quite a real-life testimony of what might happen if you don't fol-low the suggestions the Lord has given. My mistake was in belittling "the little things or the little ones" (No. 315:50). But a quote that has really helped me if I start thinking I should be doing some other task in a far-off mission field is from "The Prophecy for Davidito" where the Lord told you: "THIS IS GREATER THAN

OTHER TASKS, this is great er than other work, this is greater than great missions that God could have given unto thee, to teach the words of love of his father David unto him." (619: 10.) A VERY HAPPY NOTE TO

END WITH is how our 2 "runaways" just poured out in tears when we told them we thought we might never see them again. Our kids do have such broken hearts & are so ahead of their counterparts in the System. It's encouraging how Dad's own kids "weren't always good, & things weren't always peaceful, & we made a lot of mistakes, but because we constantly sought God's help & guidance, they certainly turned out a whole lot better than most" (315:5,6).

THE 2 BOYS I WORKED WITH know the Bible & End time Vision so well. Aladdin, at 6 years, has already read the whole Bible (a 500-page Child's Edition), so you can see how our little bit of love has gone a long way. Can you imagine what greater rev-olutionaries they will be when we give them even more love! Much love, John. (Amen! GBY!- Dad.)

I'LL START WITH SOME
SAD MISTAKES I RECENT-LY MADE with the 2 older boys, ages 7 & 6, which oth-ers may perhaps benefit from & avoid the pitfalls. To make a long story very short, I per-haps placed <u>too</u> much empha-sis on the <u>educational</u>, & even tho' we were in a "selah" situation for most of the time, I didn't really search for ways to make life exciting enough for these adventurous young

boys.
MANY AFTERNOONS I
WOULD JUST LET THEM
ROAM FREE (within certai geographic limits), instead of geographic limits, instead of getting desperate & seeking the Lord & searching the Let-ters for more stimulating things for them to do. I DON'T KNOW IF THIS IS

A COMMON TEMPTATION

to all Childcare Helpers in a Home, or whether it was a per-sonal failing for me, but I know that at times I would be lazy & not really getting answers from God for the kids & their needs, & if I was ever questioned about certain things I would get sort of defensive at times & point out all that I was doing.

I KNEW HOW BADLY CHILDCARE HELPERS ARE NEEDED & how hard it is to find them & I guess the Devil tempted me not to do my best because I knew I'd be able to get by with just being a big help in the physical, musical & educational

BUT GOD EXPECTS EVEN MOREI It's sort of like the quote about excuses in "Faith & Healing": "It's so easy to make logical, reasonable acceptable excuses why you couldn't make it—why you shouldn't make it—why you shouldn't be expected to make it, but is <u>God</u> going to excuse you?" (M:21.)

MORE RECENTLY I LET MY HEART GROW HARD to their requests & needs, & liter-ally leaned on the arm of the flesh (spankings) in my deal-

ings with them. And it eventually lead to where they ally decided to run away from home early one morningl—To escape from the spankings & routines & to fill that boyish need for adventure

THANK THE LORD THEY
FOUND THEIR WAY HOME
by the mercy of God, but not
until after we had notified the until after we had notified the police & spent hours searching for them. The Lord spoke quite clearly on how I failed, giving me over & over the verse John 15:13, about laying down our lives truly for the kids & to truly live as if they are the most important thing in the Kingdom, as Dad has so clearly tald us.

SO MANY TIMES I'VE
