Tips on Camping with Kids

From Micah & Joanne; Europe: **WE FOUND IT SOMETIMES EASY TO LET HYGIENE SLIP** below standard which is something to watch out for, particularly with children. It's important to keep their hands, nails, faces & bottoms clean & to change baby often when travelling. Be sure to disinfect cuts & insect bites. (Vinegar is a quick relief for stings.) **KEEP A DAILY CHECK ON SPECIAL BABY & CHILDREN SUPPLIES** as we found that most campgrounds don't have these things in their little store. It's worth it to pick up such items when you can & to travel with extra. **KEEP A SPARE OF ESSENTIAL BUT EASILY LOST ITEMS** such as pacifiers, nipples, bottles etc. so you're not out in the woods or on the
