AFTER READING THE RECENT ARTICLE entitled "Child Sex Shocker" published in your paper of April 6, 1980, I feel I must write to express my disgust over the sensational & untrue allegations made.

THE ARTICLE REFERRED TO A PAMPHLET "MY LITTLE FISH" which the article states that "a former member of the sect, the notorious Children of God, has told Merseyside police that he has been involved with others in distributing the pamphlet to children outside schools."

IF THIS WAS THE CASE, then your informant should have no difficulty in recalling which schools he went to & who these "others" were, & also there should be no difficulty in finding witnesses who received copies of this pamphlet, none of which appeared in the article. However I suspect that your informant is not telling the truth.

AS I HAVE MENTIONED, THE PAMPHLET DOES EXIST but it certainly does not contain "pornographic" nor involve "illustrations of a woman indulging in perverted sex with a young boy". The general public has only the written words

contained in the article to go by & therefore it could conjure up all manner of ideas.

WHAT IN FACT THE PAMPHLET IS ABOUT is the early years of childhood in which children should be taught that their bodies are a beautiful creation of God & that every part is perfectly normal, natural, good & God-made for perfectly good purposes & uses, if used in the proper way at the proper times with the proper people & in a way which is not offensive.

A CHILD'S INTEREST IN THE EQUIVALENT PARTS OF THE OPPOSITE SEX IS ALSO PERFECTLY NORMAL & natural, along with their innocent childish investigations of the same, out of normal curiosity, & should not be discouraged, condemned nor punished unless over-indulged in, offensive or actually bodily harmful to those in question.
