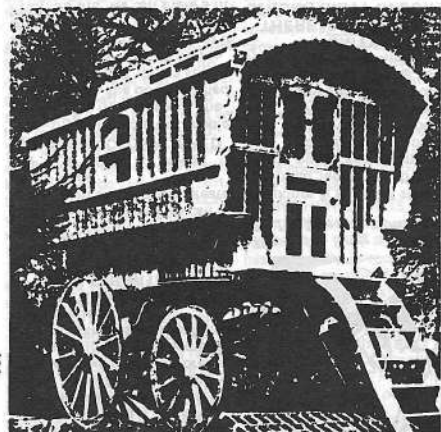

Missionaries, Children Brighten Nursing Home Valentine's Day

On Valentine's Day, the North
Bend Nursing Home had a
special visit from four smiling,
singing, happy children. The
children ranged in age from 4 to
7 years. Two (Fa-Fa and Jude)
are the children of George and
Mercy D., and the other two
(Santiago and Andres) are
the children of Adolph and Rose
S.

Both couples also have
two other children.
The children sang songs (ac-
companied by George on the
guitar) and performed a skit en-
titled "The Heart." In the skit
one of the children portrayed a
sad "heart" heard to be saying
such things as "I'm so lonely,"
and "I'm so sad, nothing makes
me happy." Then one of the
other children entered and of-
fered the "heart" the answer to
his loneliness; which is money,
but that didn't do, so the next
child entered the scene with his

answer "education." After this
failed to make the "heart" hap-
py, the third child entered and
offered "things" but this also
failed and the heart remained
sad.

But then love was offered to
the heart and happiness en-
sued; this was followed by the
children all quoting Revelation
3:20: "Behold, I stand at the
door and knock. If any man
hear my voice, and open the
door, I will come into him and
will sup with him and he with
me."

After the skit, the children
went around to all the people
hugging and sharing a little of
the love of Jesus with them.

are missionaries who have

Dearest Dad & Maria,
I AM SO THANKFUL TO
THE LORD FOR YOU BOTH
& the tremendous inspiration &
guide you are in our daily lives.
I want to write to you my testi-
mony & reaction to the Letter
"The Christmas Eve Massacre".

THERE IS A PHYSICAL &
SPIRITUAL AFFLICTION
CALLED ALCOHOLISM of not
being able to handle alcohol in
any form at any time. In the
past I had this terrible affliction
which caused me a great deal of
trouble. But when I was filled
with the Holy Spirit in 1968 I
was completely delivered from
this affliction, PTL!

IT HAD CAUSED ME A LOT
OF TROUBLE & SUFFERING,
especially to my poor wife who
was at the point of leaving me.
In 1969 I went to study in Eur-
ope & when I met & joined the
Family in 1972 God really trans-
formed my life & mind with the
words & way of living in the
Family.

SOME OF THE LEADERS
ENCOURAGED ME THAT I
WAS NOW HEALED from this
affliction & that I could handle
a bit of wine from time to time,
& indeed I did manage to handle
it & I appeared to be healed.
But as years went by I became
assistant to one leader & did a
lot of travelling all over Europe
& South America with my father
who was a king of the Family,
& I started to drink more &
more heavily.

THE LORD HAD WARNED
ME THAT BECAUSE I WAS
DISOBEYING BY INDULGING
in too much drink that He was
removing my healing of this af-
fliction, & that I was heading
for disaster. Finally after the

RNR it happened, & a terrible
jealousy problem was exposed,
& I asked the Lord to heal me
from it. But the Lord gave me
a Mo quote:

"HOW CAN YOU HAVE
FAITH FOR GOD TO BLESS
YOU WHEN YOU ARE DIS-
OBEYING? How can God bless
disobedience?" My
drinking had made me spiritual-
ly weak so that I fell prey to
the spirit of jealousy. On top of
it all I had been working for my
father for 7 years because the
Lord used him so much to help
the Family all over, but some-
times he was a cruel taskmaster.

BUT INSTEAD OF TURNING
TO THE LORD FOR HELP I
used to run to the bottle. Fin-
ally a year ago, after a quarrel
with my father I got drunk &
ready to leave everything I
bought a plane ticket to Spain.
But the Lord wouldn't let me
go by putting an angel to stop
me who didn't let me out of
sight until I was safely at home
again.

WHEN I WOKE UP THE
NEXT MORNING I CRIED
OUT TO GOD & promised Him
I would never drink again be-
cause I saw I was going to lose

my crown, my wife, my children
& my usefulness to the Family
& to Him. I put my will with
God's Will & believed, & He de-
livered me completely.

THIS MONTH IT'S BEEN A
YEAR THAT I HAVEN'T
TOUCHED ALCOHOL at all,
except a cup of wine, which
was at a meeting with an impor-
tant government official who
proposed a toast with a big glass
of whiskey. I refused but he in-
sisted on my drinking a toast
with a glass of wine. I realized
it would be an insult to refuse
so I prayed desperately before
taking it & the Lord protected
me & it had no ill effects, PTL!

I HAVE TRULY REPENTED
BY THE GRACE OF GOD &
months after my victory the
Lord made me VS of this area &
we are much happier now. I am
also getting victories over jeal-
ousy. The occasional blues I
have now are nothing compared
to the demonic attacks I & my
wife had to suffer before.

I WRITE THIS TESTIMONY
FOR ALL THE FAMILY &
plead that if any brother or sis-
ter has a drinking problem to
take very seriously Dad's Letter
"The Christmas Eve Massacre"
& cry out to God for deliverance
from the demon of alcohol. I
could not begin to tell you of the
pain & suffering & horrors that
drink has caused me & my wife
& children, & I cry out with all
my heart for any member of
the Family that has this problem,
that he will be delivered from it.

THANK GOD FOR GOD
GIVES HIM FOR US. The Lord
gave me the Scripture in Heb.
3:7-8—"When you hear my
voice, harden not your hearts as
in the day of provocation."
