LIM Goes Mobile!

Translating, typing, layout, photowork & living in a trailer!

EVEN 2 YRS. AGO WE WERE TALKING ABOUT THE POSSIBILITIES of getting a camper. But it was not until Dad came out with the Trailer Letters that we began to really have the faith for it. With this valuable info in our hands, we sat down & asked the Lord for a real good, warm, well-insulated camper big enough for our team & ministry with the Word.

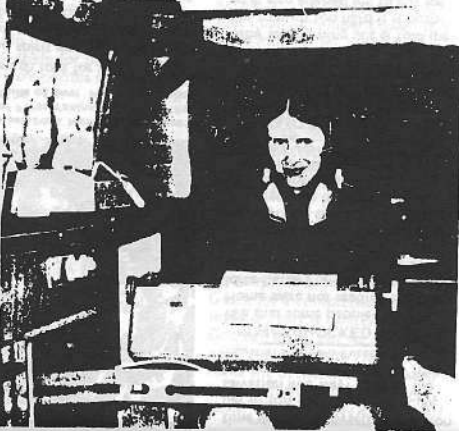
& GOD GAVE US EXACTLY WHAT WE WERE LOOKING FOR!—A '73 model with double windows, winter insulated, centrally heated, 5 1/2 meters long & 2.1 meters wide (maximum width allowed in this country) & with a cabana.

WE PARKED IT OUTSIDE THE HOME WE WERE LIVING IN & started fixing it up to suit our needs before moving in. First we took out the dirty old carpet & put linoleum in the main area, & then carpet under the tables at both ends. Then we put in 8 more socket-&-plug connections for typewriters, light-table, waxer, extra lights etc. & then we were ready to move in. We stayed warm & cozy as we continued translating to keep up with the English mag.

AT FIRST WE PLACED OUR TYPEWRITER ON ONE OF THE TABLES, which rolls up & down with a handle. But it was a bit impractical to move the typewriter back & forth everytime we were going to eat. So we got the idea to build it into a cupboard so we could roll it in & out just like a file cabinet drawer. It works real well & the typewriter can be pushed in & the door closed in 5 seconds.

FOR OUR SECURITY MATERIAL, we built a special cupboard right over the fridge, & the space between the top of this cupboard & the ceiling is just big enough for our mini light-table when not being used. We also made a new sliding door for the front room to give more privacy & peace for the translator-corrector. We made a real point of using lightweight materials as much as possible. There are usually lots of cracks & crannies you can find in campers that have not been fully used, & we found a couple of other "secret corners" to place drawers to put stuff in!

WHAT A BLESSING IT IS, as now we can move so easily—everything packed & ready to go within 1/2-hr. Before it took days! So it gives us a feeling of real security that we can evacuate the Letter lifeline at a mo-

From Sharon & the Indonesian LIT-PIC:

INDONESIA IS A VAST COUNTRY OF 145 MILLION people, the majority of whom are Muslim. But most of these people know as much about their religion as the average American knows about Christianity, & they are simply "Indonesian" above anything else. So we've found this country quite receptive to the Message & especially of course they really soak up God's Love!

ALTHO' THERE ARE LAWS HERE AGAINST CONVERTING A PERSON of another faith to your own, these laws are very lax & there is still quite a bit of freedom to distribute the Words of David, TTL!

SOME teams here in Indonesia have to be more selah than others in their outreach because of their visa situations; whereas others are able to operate more openly & are freely distributing the lit.

AMONG THE 11 SMALL HOMES throughout the country we have a very wide variety of outreaches such as "Open the Door", "Church of Love", some operating a youth club, pre-school activities for neighbourhood children, teaching English, music ministries, soon some radio ministries, D.V., FF'ing, mail ministries & lit distribution.

THE KOMIX ARE PARTICULARLY SUITABLE FOR INDONESIA because their simple pictures & message can be understood by anyone, even the illiterate. Many teams have been giving away the lit for free as they get their support in oth-

er ways & so have been reaching the poor as well as the rich. But it is still possible for some teams to get much support directly thru' litnessing.

OUR MAIN TRANSLATOR IS MICHAEL TEA who received the Lord & the Holy Spirit 3 1/2 years ago after meeting the Family & then left his former life of drugs to forsake all & serve the Lord in a new life with us. Now he's married to Sharon, an American, & they have a precious little girl of 8 months named Virginia.

MICHAEL ARTIST DOES LETTERING & ARTWORK for the Komix. He met the Family during its pioneering days 4 years ago & was saved & filled with the Holy Spirit. He's been serving the Lord full-time for 2 1/2 years. He & Deborah, from Canada, have a little Jesus' baby named Monica—10 1/2 months & are expecting their 2nd knew disciple.

THE OTHER MEMBER OF

OUR HOME IS LIES (pronounced Liz), Michael Artist's young sister who recently came to be our cook, help us with laundry (done by hand) & the children. She received the Lord & the Holy Spirit while in her hometown & has been helping the Family there for some time before coming here. Tho' Michael & Lies' family are poor, they are certainly blessed with faith & are very favourable to the Family, often have communion together in their own home as taught by Michael & the Letters & have even distributed Mo Letters themselves, GBT!

THERE ARE NOW 336 LETTERS TRANSLATED & 228 Letters in print (almost all of the 144 Basic ones are printed, & many which are not printed are available in photocopy form). There are 6 full-time national disciples in Indonesia who also have 4 knew disciples & 2 more on the way, PTL! So far they all speak & read English fairly well or very well & have been a help at some time in the production of the Words into Indonesian.

OUR MAIL MINISTRY IS JUST GETTING STARTED which we hope will soon grow into a full-fledged LIT-PIC or LIM as the regular correspondants grow in number & in Spirit to become IRFers & TRFers! Right now we are giving correspondants (most of them presently students) a basic course in the Letters with an occasional FN. We are also planning to do a type of FN with all local testimonies from around Indonesia. Recently Michael Artist visited one of the girls on the mailing list, & she & her sister (from a traditional Chinese Buddhist family) received Jesus & want to have Bible classes, TYJ! Now we want to visit other mailing list sheep, because the personal touch bears so much fruit.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PRAY FOR US here in our task of getting the words that work to the Indonesian people! We really need the support in the Spirit. The work was started in this country about 7 years ago & it seems we've just begun. Please pray for us often & for the souls in this country to really be changed & moved by the many Words of David being sown here. We're so very thankful for all the Lord's done here & that He has also never failed to abundantly provide the needed funds to operate the publications work here. And for the last year or so, He has done it mostly thru' donations of many of you brethren outside Indonesia! So we want to thank you for that, knowing that you care for the Work here, too, & manifest it in faithfully giving! If you'd like to help support the production
