We're loving every minute of it & the Lord has amply rewarded our faith in this latest turn of the Revolution OUR CAMPGROUND IS ON-LY 32 KM. FROM AN IMPORTANT SOUTHERN EUROP. EAN CAPITAL. Its owner, who also lives here in a house with his wife & 4 daughters, is quite visibly happy that we are here & shows it by giving us low-season rates during the high season, allowing us to hook up our communal weathing machine to his own water source, placing a separate bathroom & shower at our exclusive disposal, giving us our exclusive disposal, giving us occasional gifts & inviting us all to his house for Seturday-night parties, during which our chil-dren have sung & done skits, thus getting the message of the

Lord's love & salvation to this important local landowner, his family & his friends. THE EASE & EFFICIENCY OF OUR DAILY LIFE could hardly be matched by the same number of people living in, say, the same urban block. What the same urban block. What comes naturally here in our green setting would be cumber-tome, unwieldy or impossible in

concrete jungle.
I'LL GIVE YOU A FEW EX-I'LL GIVE YOU A FEW EXAMPLES: One family of 5, with
its car & trailer, pays only the
equivalent of \$150 a month to
live at the campgrounds, & for
that price they have full, unlimited use of its utilities & facilities.
WE ARE WITHIN SIGHT &
WITHIN A FEW STEPS FROM
ALL OTHERS IN OUR CAMP,
thus ensuring fellowship & mut-

thus ensuring fellowship & mut-ual assistance when the need ar-ises (& it does arise with 13 kids!) ises (& it does arise with 13 kids!) Altho' some of us have our own emergency-use portable toilets, we normally utilise the camp's own string of about a dozen indoor stalls with wash basins, & at shower time there are more than 10 awaiting without delay.

HOT WATER IS AVAILABLE FOR DISHES all day long. The campground has a mini-market for all the basics (plus some very reasonably-priced cooked meals); there are 2 telephones with direct dialing practically all over the dialing practically all over the world; the nearest town is but a 12-minute walk away & offers every conceivable service, including relaxing & cheap seaside cafes & bus service to the capital every 45 minutes.

OUR CLOSE PROXIMITY TO ONE ANOTHER & RELATIVE PRIVACY have lent themselves to real joyful evenings of fellowto real joy ful evenings of fellow-ship, either reading the latest Letter, watching something im-portant on our portable TV, or letting go at a Saturday night disco-under-a-tent, when even the babies dance. And within the last week a love-tent went up, the fruit of our youngest adult's effort to take his sexual educa-tion seriously.

HAVING NATURE AT OUR DOORSTEP gives the children unlimited space to play, while it

also teaches us to be ever more vipliant so as to prevent social.

AMERICA, & we have learned
some invaluable lessons about

ciate even more the strength,
comfort & protection that the
Family gives, & how large numbers of us could conceivably camp together without sacrific-

ing elbow room, feeling like sar dines or blowing our security. IN FACT, AS CAMPING IN S. AMERICA IS NOT AS EST-ABLISHED AS IN EUROPE & AMERICA, it may be ill-advised to pitch che benefits of sharing & fellowship, you'd miss out on the possibility of establishing a floating Family community which only camping affords.

CAMPING OUT IN EUROPE. AS OPPOSED TO THE STATES, has been a better lesson on flex-ibility because the trailer camps

here do not cater to your every e. need on a silver platter. It's no exactly roughing it, but it better prepares you for no-frills camp-

Coming To Australia?

Official gov't. requirements for residency & how to get it!

OF IMMIGRATIONS HAS AD-OPTED CERTAIN GUIDE. LINES controlling the party of OPTED CERTAIN GUIDE-LINES controlling the entry of immigrants. They state that there is no prejudice as to colour religion, country of birth, against any applicants. However, the selection criteria ensures that— ONLY RESPECTABLE & FINANCIALLY SUCCESSFUL APPLICANTS ARE LIKELY TO RECEIVE PERMANENT

TO RECEIVE PERMANENT STATUS. They don't want an influx of those likely to need welfare or special medical care (i.e. no bums & hippies, & you'd etter look like a systemite!). ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMA

NENT RESIDENCE IS DETER-MINED BY A TEST in which

the applicant scores points for various skills, assets, health or circumstance. If you score more than a certain number of points, you are allowed permanent resident status, & if you don't score the required number of points you can't come.

THE TEST EXAMINES MAT-

TERS SUCH AS: Trade skills or profession (vocational train-ing), native language (the ability to speak & read English is desirable), financial assets which one able), financial assets which one is able to bring to Australia, health (you & your dependents having good health is desirable), & other issues. For example, the applicant may score points for having skill as a typist, nurse, proceedings of the processing the control of the processing the p specialist teacher, welder or carpenter. He may also score points for having relatives out here, having a driver's license & for not having a large number of children (sad to say!).

SOME ISSUES FIGURE VERY HIGHLY ON THIS POINTS SCALE. One is that it is most important for the prospective immigrant to have a job waiting for him in Australia (even pump ing petrol will do if you have no other skills or trade). The pro-spective immigrant must undertake that he will not apply for unemployment benefits while in Australia (at least not for 3 years, until he is naturalised as an Australian citizen). THE AUSTRALIAN OFFER-ING THE JOB IS REQUIRED

TO GUARANTEE FINANCIAL SUPPORT for the immigrant.
Obviously there must be a great deal of trust between the immigrant & sponsor, because the Australian sponsor risks finding limited for account of the sponsor in the sponsor himself in serious trouble should the immigrant misbehave! As well, the sponsor would be unable to sponsor any future Fam-

ily immigrants, so it is a very

ily immigrants, so it is a very serious matter.

THIS METHOD OF OBTAIN-ING PERMANENT RESIDENCE WORKS WELL IF THE IMMI-GRANT HAS NO FUNDS of his own but has a trusted friend in Australia who will guarantee his support. The authorities will not accept that the sponsor "lives by faith". Our Yugoslav friends who run small businesses friends who run small businesses sponsor their relatives, guaranteeing them a job on arrival in

ustralia. ANOTHER ALTERNATIVE IS TO HAVE SUFFICIENT CAPITAL TO START A SUC-CESSFUL BUSINESS in Australia & to support yourself from the profits. (Until you get nat-uralised, taxation & immigration officials will be watching you to see if you are running the successful business you claimed you would. Citizenship after 3 years is not granted auto-matically. They could send you home if you failed to make a

FAMILY MEMBERS COULD FAMILY MEMBERS COULD POOL FUNDS, or God may bless somebody with a large inheritance. Alternatively, Family members with wealthy parents or Fish or kings, might persuade them to invest in Australia. Many worldly businessmen, especially Americans, are aware of the coming War & consider. of the coming War & consider Australia to be the best place in Australia to be the best place in the world to invest large sums of money. The Family immi-grants could manage the business out here on behalf of their weal-thy parents, Fish or kings.

ONE CAN BUY A BUSINESS LIKE A BISTRO for about \$20-30,000. Running a bistro doesn't involve your having a great deal of skill as a chef, unlike a restaurant. There would be a lot of hard work, but it could be a good place for wit-nessing (singing, FF'ing). ANOTHER ENTERPRISE

MORE SUITED TO THE COM-MORE SUITED TO THE COM-ING CRASH would be to pur-chase a farm & become a pri-mary producer (i.e. set up a ref-uge). However, one needs a min imum of \$50,000 to purchase & develop a property to an income

SO, THE PERSON WITH NO MONEY, SKILLS OR WAITING JOB IS UNLIKELY TO BE GRANTED PERMANENT RES-IDENCE, unless of course, they marry an Australian. What can one do? One could start to ac-quire skills which are assessed by performance rather than education, perhaps by taking a short-duration "hobby" course at a technical college. Examples include typist, welder, draftsman (I built up an architectural drafting business with no qualifica-tions as a draftsman.) Most tions as a drattsman.) Most trade skills (e.g. carpenter) are assessed by completion of a 4-year apprenticeship, & are thus not suitable.

ONE WOULD THEN HAVE TO FIND SOMEONE IN AUSTRALIA TO EMPLOY HIM.

Few Family members have bus-inesses, & no businessmen will employ someone they don't know. Perhaps Australian Fam-ily members should make a spe-cial offect to get make a cial effort to get more business men turned on to the Family (Jesus!), so that they will want sponsor immigrants.
ACQUIRING SUITABLE

SKILLS IS DESIRABLE, as "living by faith" alone will not

get you into Australia perman ently. You could work in your promised job awhile & gradually get into witnessing in a self-supporting fashion.
HOWEVER, WHEN YOU AP-PLY FOR CITIZENSHIP 3 yrs.

later, the authorities will want to know how you have supported yourself, so it is advisable to have proof of having held a partime job, or having been self-employed in a small-scale business that paid taxes, even if you were spending a lot of your time witnessing.

FF'ERS COULD WORK FOR ESCORT AGENCIES, for example. We would hate to see anyone sliding into the system away later, the authorities will want

ENT RESIDENCE WHILST ONE IS IN AUSTRALIA ON A VISITOR'S VISA! By applying, you risk getting yourself deport-ed whilst a tourist! You are granted permission to visit Australia only by undertaking that you will definitely go back.
ONE MUST MAKE APPLICATION FOR PERMANENT RESIDENCE FROM YOUR

NATIVE COUNTRY. You do score a few points for having previously visited Australia as a tourist. A wise thing to do

might be to come out here on a visitor's visa & use the time to try to line up a definite job offer, or several offers, even working for your prospective sponsor for a while in the hope of impressing them. Male or female FF'ers should spend their tourist time FF'ing business persons like mad! Pray hard for the Lord to lead you to the right

BUT YOU WILL STILL
HAVE TO RETURN TO YO
NATIVE LAND & apply for permanent residence from there, permanent residence from there with proof of a definite job of fer accompanying your application & tipping the points assessment in your favour. An intention to invest capital in Australian ia, saying that you intend to later run your own business after you have worked awhile, would probably win the system's

HARMLESS AS DOVES!" It is not impossible for Family members to get permanent residence in Australia. However they do need vision, drive, en-thusiasm, initiative, prayer, "shtick", & knowing that they are in God's Will! P.S. An interesting Biblical parallel is found in Acts: Paul's Roman citizenship sure got him out of a lot of scrapes, & gave him lots of free-doms, & it could even be one reason why God chose Paul.
