1980 due to an electrical fire in our trailer. Their Homegoing really broke our hearts & has taught us so many lessons we couldn't even begin to tell it all. But we want to send this to you so all may benefit from our misso all may benefit from our mis-

takes.
KNOWING THAT WE'RE RESPONSIBLE for the children's
deaths & that it could have been
avoided has been such a fight for
us, but we're just believing &
claiming the poem that "things

claiming the poem that "things don't just happen to children of God; they're planned"—in spite of our mistakes.

DAVID & I ARE WORKING WITH A SISTER NAMED ANNA who just rejoined the Family with her four girls after 9 years of being in the System—Ruth-8, Lamb-6, Mercy-3 & Deborah-2.

THE LORD HAD GIVEN US A VAN that we'd converted into a camper & planned on going to Mexico & really reach the world

Mexico & really reach the world with God's Love. And so, need ing more space for the rest of the Family,

WE BOUGHT A SMALL POP-IP CAMPER because it is so UP CAMPER because it is so light for our van to pull, the lightest trailer made. (Our van was so heavy itself that it need-

ed something light to pull.)
THEN WE LEFT FOR MEXI-CO where we were staying in a trailer park there. Some other brethren were there with their trailer too-Lance, Lydia, Daniel & their 3 children.

THAT NIGHT EVERYONE TO SEE A MOVIE "Bili-

tis" & I watched the children in the pop-up. When everyone came back, as it was so late, we didn't really want to wake up the children & move them from

trailer to trailer THAT WAS OUR FIRST MIS-THAT WAS OUR FIRST MIS-TAKE: Letting all the children sleep alone, thinking it was ok as it was late etc. It was the first time we'd ever done that, & it's the last time we'll do it tool

the last time we'll do it tool God help usl! IT WAS SO COLD WE PUT A HEATER IN THE POP-UP, using a small extension cord. That was our next mistake, as it was too many amp's for that small extension cord, which small extension cord, which

started the fire.
AFTER THE FIRE WE READ THE "WATCH YOUR WATTS WARNING from Dad. We had just received the mailing a few just received the maining a lew days prior to the fire & were just reading the Letters. From that the Lord showed us the importance of getting together & reading the Mags from front to back. "If we only had!" It's so said to learn these lessors the sad to learn these lessons the

hard way, by experience, but the LeMS because of going thru' such a trauma, maybe never talk. THAT NIGHT ALL OF US HAD RECEIVED LITTLE CHECKS about leaving the children & even about the heater, but yereyone of us blew it off, Lord help us! What a sad way to learn these things at the expense of the hest with the standard to the stand Dad, was, "Accidents don't just happen" & to remember to pray without ceasing, especially when little lives are in our hands to pro

ran in to get the children out & David to try & put out the fire.

When I went in there was a small fire & mostly a lot of smoke, but right after getting 3 children out in just a matter of seconds it instantly caught the canvas part in flames. The canvas & plastic windows was really if

dows were really flammable.
THE CHILDREN WERE BURN-THE CHILDREN WERE BURN-ED BADLY with 1st, 2nd & 3rd degree burns, also because they were covered with a sleeping bag made of polyester that caught fire instantly & burned them bad-ly. We rushed them to the hospi-tal where they were immediately given oxygen & doctors tried to clean out their lungs because they had breathed all that burning plas-tic which really damaged their tic which really damaged their

FOR TWO DAYS THEY WERE IN A GOV'T. SOCIAL SECUR-ITY HOSPITAL, but because we ITY HOSPITAL, but because we were Americans & because they didn't have the proper facilities, they were transferred to a children's hospital where they did all they could for the girls.

AND SO AT 4 A.M. WE WERE had improved so much & started
AWAKENED BY THE CHILDREN'S CRYING, & we saw
there was a fire in the trailer. I

We were really encouraged that
the Lord was going to raise her up & miraculously heal her. But then she began to whimper

& we saw how much pain she was in & asked the Lord that His will be done, not ours. BECAUSE WE LOVED &

WANTED HER SO MUCH w were willing to do anything so she could live, but then could see she didn't want to suffer all the pain & agony. And just mir utes later Mercy too went Home Praise the Lord! His ways are not our ways, & the Lord truly

OUT OF WHAT SEEMED LIKE DEFEAT CAME SOME OF GOD'S GREATEST VICTOR-IES, as we got to witness to a lot of people who were going thru' the same trials without the Lord, & we were able to comfort others with the same comfort that we are comforted with, PGI

THE LORD OPENED DOORS TAL to witness, & the Lord gave us about 15 souls including a nurse who was watching the girls. And we went to an orphanage where the Lord gave us 30 souls

where the Lord gave us au sours too, TYJI THEY ARE AS THE ANGELS IN HEAVENI Amen! WLY so much & can't thank you enough for your words of life that really give us life to fight on & keep on. Lord forgive us for all our mis-takes & hopefully all can learn

from them.
THE LORD IS SHOWING US SO MANY THINGS it's hard to tell you all of it. One of the things is that I've never experienced death or things like that & that God really used it to pre-

pare us for the future as "1000 shall fall by thy side & 10,000 at thy right hand but it shall no come nigh thee" (Ps. 91:7). So in times to come we're going to see a lot of pain & death & we'll be their only hope. There's

2. Obey All Checks! Don't regard anything as being too little or unimportant.

3. Be Prepared! Have safety

De rreparegi Have safety drills in cases of fire. Teach chil-dren what they can do, using fire extinguisher, helping littler children, covering their mouths

etc.

4. <u>Do Not Leave Children A-lonel</u>

Even sleeping close may not be close anough.

5. Hospitals & Doctors: Know where they are located & if they will serve you. Find good doc-tors who may help you in time of need.

6. Re-read all the Trailer Letters! They are so important, & everything we need to know is in there. God help us! Our children!—Sad Ded!) there. God help usl

THE LORD ALSO SHOWED US THAT SLEEPING BAGS MADE OF POLYESTER ARE BAD.—They can burst into flames instantly. Use wool blankets instead. Also kids' pajamas should be wool. Synthetics are more dangerous & flammable. POP-UP TENT TRAILERS.

THE REST OF THE CHILDREN & I ARE HEALING UP
MIRACUL OUSLY FAST with a
few minor burns, nothing serious, lets (the one that caught fire)
Thank God we have our lives, as was located by a seat cushion, it could have cost all of our lives!
In fact we could barely plug anyline stakes! Everything is serious in caring for God's children.
HERE'S A CHECKLIST of things the Lord has showed us to do to be more prepared:
1. Pray Without Ceasing! The recommend piling on blankets instead of using dangerous electric heaters. In fact, I would rec-

IN POP-UP TRAILERS, but I recommend piling on blankets instead of using dangerous electric heaters. In fact, I would recommend not using electricity at all in them, as they're so flam

ALSO, MAKE FRIENDS ALSO, MAKE FRIENDS
WITH NEIGHBOURS. One of
our neighbours put out the fire
for us. It would also be good to
have other means of transportation nearby besides your own.
It would be good if at least one
person, if not more, studied up
on first aid or took a free course.
They usually give them at Civil
Defense or Red Cross. It's all
in the "Child Safety Checklist"!

NOTE ON THE "MEDUSA COUCH":

Dearest Ones. (Sent by Our Research Dept. in London, Feb. 1981) I thought you might be interested in the following description I obtained whilst at the British Library: RE: MEDUSA & MONSTERS!

"Gorgon: Homer spoke of a single Gorgon - a monster of the underworld. The later Greek poet Hesiod increased the number of Gorgons to three - STHENO (the Mighty), EURYALE, (the Par Springer), and MEDUSA (the Queen) and made them the daughters of the sea-god PHOREYS and of his sister CETO. The Attic tradition regarded the Gorgon as a monster produced by GE, the goddess Earth, to aid her sons against the gods.

In early classical art the Gorgons were portrayed as winged female creatures, their hair consisting of snakes; they were round-faced, flat-nosed, with tongues lolling out and with large projecting teeth. MEDUSA was the only one of the three who was mortal; hence PERSEUS was able to kill her by cutting off her head. From the blood that ran from her neck sprang CRYSAOR and PEGASUS, her two sons by POSEIDON. The head had the power of turning all who looked at it into stone. The hideously grotesque original type of the Gorgoneion, as the Gorgon's head was called, was used generally as a protection against the evil eye. Modern anthropologists that MEDUSA, whose virtue was really in her head, was perhaps originally a ritual mask"

As I walk through different parts of the British Museum, I am amazed at the large number of these idols and images from all different cultures. It seems somehow incredible that the craftsmen didn't have the insight to see what they were illustrating and that people today still do not understand their significance. It certainly makes me very thankful for the protection of the Lord and His Holy Spirit - I certainly don't want to pick up any hitch-hikers from them, thanks very much There are few cultures whose gods are in any way beautiful, and in the East particularly, they seem to be universally gnotesque, yet it is to the East that so many young people go to seek enlightenment. It certainly makes one appreciate the Lord and the Family even more when brought face to face with such!
