Then saith He unto His disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth labourers into His harvest. --Mt.9:37,38.

And daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ. --Acts 5:42.

And if by grace, then is it no more of works: Otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: Otherwise work is no more work. --Ro.11:6.

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost. --Titus 3:5.

Whereas ye know not what shall be on the morrow. For what is your life? It is even a vapour, that appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away. --James 4:14.

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever. --Heb.13:8.

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: No man cometh unto the Father, but by Me. --John 14:6.

That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. --1Cor.2:4,5.

These things have I written unto you that believe on the Name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the Name of the Son of God. --1John 5:12,13.

And he that taketh not his cross and followeth after Me, is not worthy of Me. --Mt.10:36-38.
