MAKE A BIKINI!

HERE ARE SOME IDEAS FOR MAKING YOUR OWN RIKINI--customised to suit your personality & figurel Tou can use almost any fairly thin material for the suit. Jersey works very well as it is a bit stretchy. For knits & jersey, see seams, hems & tunnels with a narrow sig-sag stitch if possible, which will stretch with the material. If a woven material, not knited, is used, be sure to zig-sag edges after cutting, or turn edges under twice on hems & tunnels to keep them from revelling. If you're a good seamstress you sight want to make matching time from the same material as your suit, but it's easier to use soft cord which you can find in the sawing department of big stores. Even shoe laces can make good ties (look for the kind that is one continuous piece which you cut to the right length). You will need only a few scrape of material for the suit, (if you buy material, 30 cm is enough), & 3 to 4 meters of soft correspondents.

STARTING AT THE TOP: Here's a pattern that looks nice on girls with small breasts! Cut two quarter circles, 16% cm on each straight side. Turn under the straight edges to form merrow hem, stitch. Turn under the curved edges 1% cm to make tunnels, stitch. Cut 2 pieces of cord 5 cm long. Sew one to corner "a" of each triangle. Knot free ends. Cut one piece of cord 110 cm long. Thread thru both tunnels, knot ends.

For girls with larger breasts, make each triangle from 2 smaller triangle shapes sewn together (see "Mountain-Mei Pattern on opposite page. This gives more fullness to the cup. Sew "Side-Front A" to "Center-Pront B" on the curred edges, matching notches. Proceed as above, turni under straight edges, making tunnels & attaching tice at

COURTHE BOTTOM: Use a favorite panty as a pattern, one Bottos Back and one Bottos Front, placing each pattern on fold of material. For very thin or semi-transparent material, cut 2 Bottos Fronts for double thickness (keeping two pieces together, treat as one piece of material). For woven, not knit material, cut on bias for better fit. Sew bottom seam matching notches. Turn under front & back top edges to form marrow hem, stitch. Turn under front & back top edges to make tunnels, stitch. Cut 2 pieces of clastic 2 cm shorter than top edges of front & back. Thread these pieces of elastic thru their tunnels & sew ends of elastic securely to panty corners. Cut 2 pieces for clastic securely to panty corners. Cut 2 pieces for cord 15 cm long. Sew firally to back corners of bikini bottoms (thread on beads if desired) then sew firally to front corners of bikini bottom. Be sure to try it on to adjust cords to right length. OR cut \$ pieces of cord 25 cm long & sew 1 piece to each corner of panty. Tie on sides as illustrated.
