Converted Van Happy Home For 7!

How we converted our large van to comfortably & securely house all 7 of us!

From Arthur Newlove: LOVING GREETINGS TO YOU ALL! The last few months have been very exciting for us because after reading "Americans Abroad" & all the Letters & info pertaining to South America, we know God was speaking to our hearts about making this our new destination & the land of the future for our children.

SINCE THEN WE HAVE BEEN BUSY WITH OUR PREPARATIONS & the raising of funds & support from home. The Lord has been leading us step by step, & one of the first ones was when we had a mini-revolution in our own living accommodations!

LAST SUMMER DURING A 10-DAY FAITH TRIP IN JUST OUR VAN without our caravan, we discovered how much more mobility, flexibility, security & ease of working we could attain by leaving our caravan behind. So we decided to fix up our van as a proper camper & then sell the caravan, using the funds towards our fares to South America. Reading Dad's testimonies of car camping really gave us the faith to do it, as our big van is quite comfortable compared to Dad's first station wagon!

FIXING UP THE VAN FOR LIVABILITY TOOK JUST 3 WEEKS with only a hand saw & drill, using materials the Lord gave us at a very good discount. It was a real miracle watching it come together. Hallelujah! The Lord gave us a beautiful little home out of almost nothing but wood, nails & varnish!

AFTER TRYING IT OUT FOR SIZE THESE PAST FEW MONTHS, WE REALLY LIKE LIVING IN IT! We feel that for us & our mobile ministry it works much better living from our camper only. Altho' simple, the van is comfortable & homey, &

after having lived on the road now for almost two years we have been able to get down to simple basic camping.

KEEPING IN MIND THE NEED TO BE A GOOD SAMPLE, we decided to invest some funds to buy new wood & a few finishing touches which will add to the eventual resale value. The kids love it too, & all 7 of us fit just fine. Even with all our survival, camping equipment, books etc., we are well within the carrying capacity of the van & are more efficient than ever before. Here's

how we did it: WE DECIDED TO UTILIZE THE OTHERWISE WASTED FRONT DRIVING COMPARTMENT area by making a bed

which drops down from the ceiling at night & which remains clipped to the roof during the day. This bed is big enough for 2 small children or one big child, & Gabriel, now 10½, sleeps there, & it is easy enough for him to manoeuvre up & down by himself.

THE MIDDLE EATING AREA is made up of two large storage benches on one side where we

keep our survival foods & a table which converts into a double bed at night. On the other side we have a kitchen cabinet & cooker & other cupboards, as well as our potty & hang-up closet.

AT THE BACK OF THE VAN we have another "U"-shaped seating area which includes three large storage benches for school materials, extra clothes & survival food. We also built a see-thru' bookcase which separates the eating area from the back lounge!

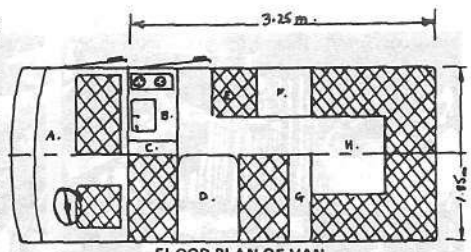
Hal! This whole area at the back converts to our big double bed at night or during the day can nap three children. A single bunk bed high up at the back of the van serves as a storage area for all our bedding during the day & is another bed for a child at night.

WE USED ONE BIG PIECE OF LINOLEUM TO COVER THE FLOOR & around the base of the walls & seats plus up the walls of the potty enclosure, which makes spills & messes easy to clean. The lino seals off the seats, benches & wall to make the floor waterproof, so our survival never gets wet. We each have a bed, a seat & closet space, plus plenty of storage in floor & ceiling lockers.

WE LEFT THE WALLS CLEAR AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE to give a "longer" look to the van. Thank God for Dad's advice & experience on "one pot" meals, as it revolutionized the space needed in our kitchen, the most important shelf now being for our pressure cooker!

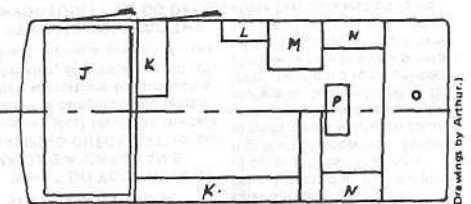
SO THAT'S HOW 5 CHILDREN & 2 ADULTS LIVE IN SUCH A SMALL SPACE of only 3½ meters x 1.85 x 1.85 meters. It works very well & has brought us even closer together, hal!

With greater unity, PTL! Even on cold snowy days when we are inside for longer periods it works great, the secret being to keep everybody occupied & working on various projects. In-

ulation throughout the van makes it even warmer than our caravan used to be. Hallelujah!

ANOTHER THING WE DECIDED TO AIM FOR WAS A "CLEAN EXTERIOR", so we don't have a roof rack but store everything we need inside. If there is no room for it we make room or we forsake it, & this is a constant process, hal!

WELL, WE NOW PREFER TRAVELLING & LIVING IN ONE VEHICLE & are very en-

couraged by the results. We now know what works best for us, & when we reach our destination it will be much easier to reconstruct our little Heavenly Home in a short time even with just a few hand tools. And one thing we know for sure is that when we reach S.A. we want to stay mobile as long as possible, Lord helping us! Hallelujah! Try it! You might like it! WLY! —Arthur & family.
