

**TIP ON WITNESSING TO MUSLIMS:** "During Ramadan I was questioned several times a day as to why I was eating during the day, a forceful, almost condemning kind of questioning (see 'The Fan' 626:17a). Then the Lord reminded me how in a book I was reading about Mohammed it mentioned that it says in the Koran that the members of the 3 major religions shouldn't dispute, since God is the final judge. The book gave the reference which I looked up (Sura 5:51,53). Reading a little bit more in that section (starting at phrase 47) I found something very useful (just like Psalm 119:42). From there up to phrase 53 it tells the Muslims that Jews should follow the Law of Moses, & Christians should follow 'the light of the Gospel' & that God would judge later on according to each party's respective book. In phrases 68-69 of Sura 5: 'If only the People of the Book (ie—Jews & Christians) had stood fast by the Law & the Gospel, they would have enjoyed happiness on every side.' (Like John 13:17!) This was exactly what I needed! Since finding this I have answered my accusers right out of their own book which has put them immediately to silence, even, I believe, a certain amount of respect. Plus, I can say with boldness, 'I am a Christian!' TTL!"
