EVERY CASE WILL BE DIFFERENT, & only prayer, love &
understanding will help him.
You will have to trust the Lord to do the rest, & it may be pretty hard to see your child being broken by the Lord.



NOT LIKELY TO HAVE TOO MANY CASES OF REBELLION in the Family. already, or children approaching adolescence, may have joined when your children were well past the first impressionable year past the first impressionab If these children are showi signs of rebellion you may be tempted to think, "Oh well, it's tempted to think, "On well, it's not his fault, he had such a rough time in the System," or "There's no hope, the System's ruined him," or as in our case, be tempt-ed to blame bad handling by inexperienced & authoritarian lead ership of the past

DON'T WORRY OR FRET, BUT PRAY FAITHFULLY, & your little lamb will come back to the fold. I've found in my ex perience that it is far better to let the <u>Lord</u> deal with your old-er child than to lay down the

law yourself.

GIVE LOVING COUNSEL & ENCOURAGEMENT, BUT LET THEM CHOOSE whom they THEM CHOOSE whom they will serve—themselves & the System, or the Lord. They'll come back. "Train up a child in the way he should go; & when he is old, he will not depart fror it" (Prov. 22:6). One of the hardest things to bear is to see the Lord dealing with your children. dren! All you can do is pray & love them & let your good sample convict them.

I COULD TELL THE EFFECT SHE HAD on the patients & hospital staff by the way she is greeted each time she goes back for an appointment. In fact, the head doctor of the Medicine Dept. offered us any help he could & was extremely sweet & kind to us. In turn I found him an English teacher (a dear sweet American sister) & he is now her helpful & loving Fish, saved & really turned on to the Word.

UP AT NIGHT with such a pain ful itching in her toes that she'd be crying & use the only relief she could find, cold water at high pressure from the tap. times we'd wake up & our hearts sank to hear the running water in the bathroom on the occasions that she didn't wake us up.

A COUPLE OF TIMES I CAME BACK HOME TO FIND HER FIGHTING BACK TEARS as "accidentally" she'd come a-cross horrific stories of people cross horrific stories of people who were dying slowly of lupus, & of women who had horribly deformed faces because of the disease. How the Enemy loves to use fear as one of his main weapons! Can you imagine the trial! We were totally unable to help her.
