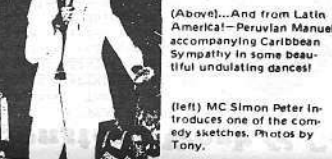

By a miracle of God no one was hurt & the damage was limited in comparison to what it could have been.

BUT WE THOUGHT IT WAS SERIOUS ENOUGH TO STOP THE WHOLE CAMP & get desperate & down to business with the Lord about where we had failed. "Nothing happens to His children but by His will & with His permission" & we really felt that the Lord was angry with us for not investing enough into our own children & teaching enough the "fear of the Lord which is the beginning of wisdom" to our growing little ones. Reading together as a body "What is That in Thy Hand?" & Ho's lesson on "Love & Discipline", we realised how we had neglected this very needed Daddy-time & consistency in our disciplining of the children, as well as rewarding them for their good deeds. This was certainly a real lesson for all of us who got so busy

in our world that we hadn't heeded His checks.

It seems that the 5 of them, two young Swiss girls & three Italians, were at a crisis point in their lives, & by His mercy He brought about a great victory. But we felt like sharing this lesson so you don't have to have such a catastrophe happen in order to get you desperate about your children!
