INCIDENTALLY, I JUST HEARD ON BBC before we left England a documentary on "The History of Multi-Track Recording" the very last installment of which ended with the "latest innovation" in studio recording—live recording of entire orchestra, singer & all, not even onto tape but directly onto the master acetate disc! So, I'd say what you gave from the Lord is not "old fashioned" at all!—Maybe a little ahead of its time!

THE ONLY PREREQUISITE OF COURSE is the musicians, back-up vocalists & lead vocals need ample time to rehearse sufficiently to make a smooth delivery of any intricate passages & know their parts well. As I say, I think it's going to be great for the Show, the public & us to concentrate on doing it "one time from the top"!—With feeling! I love you,—Micah.
