There were two mills in the city so we provisioned 44 kilos of whole wheat flour & have been able to share it with other Homes in the next city. We got a lot of small things we needed by going storeto-store. Also we provisioned a doctor for a check-up for me. I'm doing really well with this pregnancy & it has been a real blessing. Due date is Sept. 6th. THE KIDS SORES HEALED UP IN TWO DAYSI—With prayer, vitamins & a lot of extra work to keep everyone clean. We're having to be more careful about cleanliness & health etc., as some places are not so clean & sanitary.

WE ARE A TEAM OF FIVE ADULTS & NINE CHILDREN, with two vehicles, two trailers & a tent. It has been a real revolution working together, & a real blessing. There is always a lot

We are so grateful for the help with the children. Simon & Becky have become the kids' teachers, lovers & companions, & Zack is a very good handyman.
