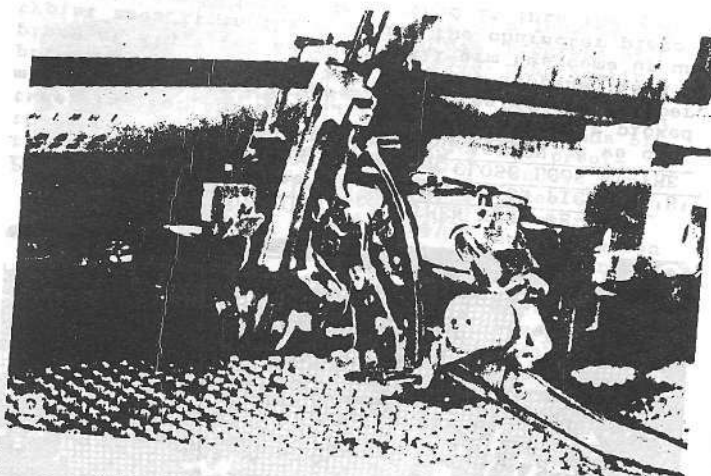
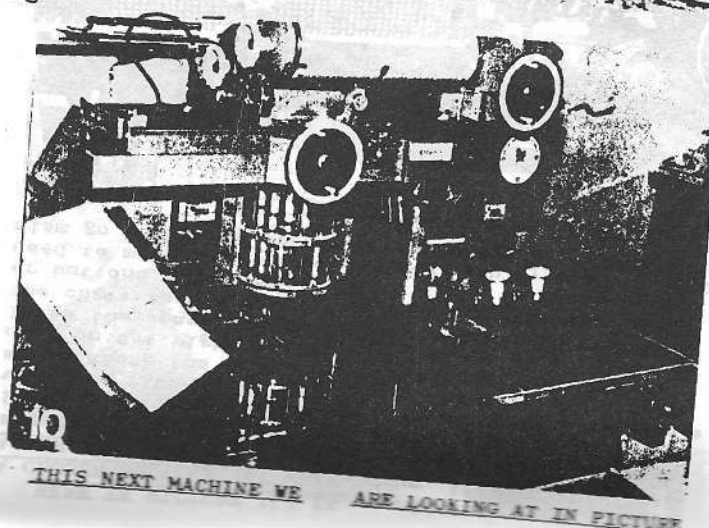

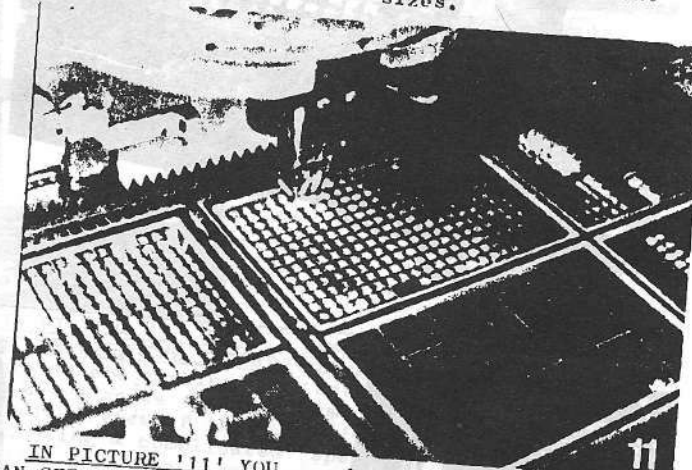

THIS NEXT MACHINE WE ARE LOOKING AT IN PICTURE

'10' IS A CHINESE PHOTO-TYPE MACHINE. We don't have one of these ourselves, as they are very expensive. This is used for typing our titles & other Chinese characters. As you can see, it looks somewhat like the other

Chinese typewriter, but it is quite a bit bigger. In the middle of the machine you can see a series of tubes which are actually lenses. Combinations of these produce the type in different sizes.

IN PICTURE '11' YOU CAN SEE A CLOSE-UP OF THE CHARACTER TRAY, & you can see the characters with the light coming from underneath. The characters in this case are on small glass plates which look like printing negatives. Going back to picture '10' you can see the white barrel on the top of the machine. It's inside this that the photopaper is. The image of the character is projected from the

lenses onto this photopaper & later it is developed like ordinary photos. NOW TO PICTURE '12', & WE ARE LAYING OUT THE TYPING on the "Spirit Tree" TK. The typeset has been done to fit over the English words. IN PICTURE '13' we have the photo-typeset title put on the front page, & now the Komic is ready for printing, after a final check for any mistake in layout or typing.
