Dear Family,

Greetings from Cagayan de Oro, one of the major cities of the Southern Philippines, where we are labouring to reach a vast area with the Words of life. We just wanted to share with you some exciting testimonies of what the Lord did here recently.

TWO SCHOOL PROGRAMS NET 1100 SOULS!!!

During the past month we were able to perform at 2 schools before a total of 1500 elementary & high school students. The first part of our

program was made up of songs including "Nice To Be Here", "You Gotta Be A Baby" in English, Cebuano, & Tagalog & several others. Then Pandita & Sammy, both 3 yrs old, came on and really stole the show singing "The Time To Be Happy", "Jesus Loves the Little Children" & others.

Following them in the program was our talented skit team of Lance & Meadow who did the famous "Holy Holes" skit. The first part of the skit got everyone laughing & then they really listened & drank in the last part where the lonely boy gets the "hole" in his heart filled by asking Jesus in. Then Joy, who is a national, came to the microphone & explained the message of the skit in the lo-

cal language to make sure that everyone understood. Sammy & Pandita came back & quoted Rev 3:20 & Jn 3:16, after which Joy led the audience in a simple prayer to receive Jesus in the local dialect. These 2 programs resulted in a total of 1100 souls being saved!!!

The Japanese NAF was surely this Heaven on earth! Over 250 family members from all over Japan gathered in one area for four days of love, fellowship, sharing, counselling, praying, listening to the Lord, and decision making, the likes of which were never seen before.

For almost 2 months the homes in the Tokyo area had been provisioning and preparing for the mighty influx of brethren from the other areas of Japan. As Tokyo had the greatest density of family members as well as the largest houses we all felt it would be the most economical to have all the brethren stay at the homes in and around Tokyo. So the family here all worked together in love and harmony to get things set up, found a hall, provisioned bedding food, and needs for the big event. Needless to say the Lord supplied abundantly.

The original date was set for the 13th-15th but since we couldn't find a hall for those days we moved it up to the 20th-23rd.

Also inspite of all the sacrifices they had to make, quite a few of the brethren from other areas arrived in Tokyo safely from all over Japan by helping each other. TYJ!

--1st Day--
The first day was solid inspiration from 11:00-5:00 as we gathered in the rental hall. Each LAS introduced his area sharing such facts as how many families and major outreaches. It was amazing how many families are obeying the Busking Letter! During this time we had an election for the NAS. Ahikim & Lamb were elected. This was followed by a short break for lunch which the Lord miraculously supplied, 300 ham & cheese sandwiches along with plenty of drinks, all for free! TTL!

Then an exciting slide show of the family in Japan--from the original pioneers Medad, Abby & Leedah up to the present. Everyone had a good laugh and inspiring time.

Next was a short spot for special announcements--mostly pleas for laborers as they are so few and then the shiners were introduced. This was inspiring and convicting for all! "Oh, one more announcement" says Ezra--a plea for support for Ongaku No Kagi (Musical Key) and-- out come the musicians for a conical end as they busk for support! Much to everyone's surprise, especially Ezra's the brethren started flowing forward placing donations in the guitar case, over ¥50,000. GB our loving family.

The following day was open for more fellowship and quiet sharing. Two different homes on opposite ends of Tokyo rented halls to show videos for those who hadn't seen them. Needless to say there was lots of love and sharing and as Mike said "It's never too late for love!" seems to be the theme song!

We were able to capture on video, thanks to Abraham, some beautiful dances performed by some of our lovely sisters. It was virtually unplanned and unprepared for but it turned out so beautiful! We hope you get to see it! --AMEN!

--3rd Day--
The third day we were all back together at the big auditorium for more fellowship, prayer, and forming different committees to get things done. The Lord's Spirit really fell as we united our hearts with communion and prayer and quietly waiting for the Lord to speak. And speak He did, inspiring us to work more in unity and to get out and go into all the world.

--4th Day--

He really love you. We wanted to share all of the wonderful things that the Lord has done for us this month. After receiving a letter from Keda and Yamuko about how short the time is that we have, and how we need to get the show aired before the war; the Lord has given us great conviction for this work and it is absolutely amazing the amount of change and progress that has occurred here in the last 3 weeks! Hal-lu-lu-lu!

Our beginning steps were two big decisions... First, the name of the show: "Ongaku No Kagi" (Musical Key). Secondly, Naomi as the DJ... She then proceeded to make a Demo Program for Dnd, and during the last portion of the recording of show 2b, with just 2 songs to go, Naomi, who was 5 mon.

It was necessary for her to go to the hospital right away, where she was put in for complete bed-rest to try and save the child. She had a very high fever, so they ran tests and found her white blood-cell count to be over 10X greater than normal. It appeared to be due to a kidney infection and the doctors had no idea how long she would have to stay there... To say the least this threw a wrench into our work here!

It was then that our convictions for Naomi to be the DJ began to slide. Our faith began to wane because we had based the decision of Naomi Ding the show on various confirmations against ourselves and others instead of hearing straight from the Lord and claiming His word. So when this big test came from the Lord, our house that was built on the sand-- it fell.
