Helpful Food Tips From S.America

Practical Advice On How To Eat Healthier In The Tropics

After living in the Tropics for one year now, I wanted to share a few of the helpful tips we have learned, in hopes of helping other families who have recently arrived.

Lemon & garlic: Like Dad said "Even the saphrophytes & parasites love those climates, too, & they'll either choose you as their host or your clothes or your shoes to live in or on so watch out!" (LNF for Mag 45:71) We have found that we have to be very diligent to prevent stomach difficulties caused by germs & parasites, so we try to

eat garlic every day & also the juice of lemon is a very good preventative. Sometimes, instead of soaking our salad vegetables in water to which iodine has been added, we put lots of lemon juice on our vegetables. Although lemons are laxative, they also are very good in cases of diarrhoea, as they help kill the "bug" causing the trouble.

Herbal Tea: We also have found a good selection of herbal teas in the natural stage unpacked & loose -- they look like weeds at our supermarket at a very cheap price. Most outdoor mar-

kets even have a larger selection!

Molasses: If your country has sugar cane, it probably has black strap molasses, as we found out here. Health food shops sell it for expensive prices, but the Ministry of Agriculture sold us some for only \$ US .07 per gallon. They normally use it to feed the animals. Then we were able to provision a big barrel full from a liquor company which made liquor from sugar cane.

Brown rice: Although our country produces lots of rice, brown rice is just unheard of (except in the expensive health food shops). But we discovered that the machines that peel the rice can be stopped immediately after it takes off the outer husk & the rice (which is "brown", as it hasn't been totally processed) can be taken out, without having to continue

through the machine. So a friendly farmer gave us some healthy rice, when we explained this to him! PTL!

Brewers Yeast: We also have been able to find brewers yeast from our local brewery, but it was in liquid form, & had to be refrigerated & since we were not sure of the potency or how much to use, etc we haven't been using it.

Quick cookies: Here is a way to make healthy cookies really quick. Mix together: raw oats, molasses, & margarine until the consistency is so that you can form it into small balls. Put the balls on a well greased fry pan on a low flame & press down with a spoon until flat. When brown on one side, turn over & brown on other side too. You can add other ingredients such as cinnamon, allspice, peanut butter, grated coconut, or substitute honey for molasses.

We had given our papers and documents to a lawyer here who had promised to obtain visas for us. Days, weeks, and months passed by without any definite results and finally we came to the realization that we would just have to take care of the matter ourselves. In the end we were faced with a \$600 (US) fine due to the failure of the lawyer to properly transmit the papers.

We are a family of five and visas and legal matters often take a great deal of our time. So, when a lawyer offered his services to help with our visas, we considered it a great way to save the Lord's time and money. He (the lawyer) could travel and do all the paper work in the distant capital city while we stayed here and spent our energy on the Lord's work. In the end the Lord showed us that the enemy was just using the lawyer to hinder our efforts and, that if we would just step out by faith, He would do the rest. Due to certain circumstances and what the Lord showed us in prayer, we decided that I (Crystal) should go to the capital city with our youngest child. (The day before leaving the Lord miraculously provided an airplane ticket.) I knew the Lord would have to do a miracle because I knew very little if nothing about legal affairs.

Upon arriving, the Lord miraculously opened the doors and within a couple of days all of the required papers had been turned in. When I was told that we would have to pay a fine so I began visiting various officials in order to get this waived. All were very helpful and sympathetic but all came to the same conclusion; we would have to pay a fine. What a shocker it was when I heard the amount would be \$600. The lawyer had repeatedly told us, "Don't worry, I'll take care of everything; you won't have to pay a thing." He! It is better to trust in the Lord than to put confidence in man." (Psalm 118:8)

Well, it took several more days to undo all the damage that the lawyer had done. We prayed desperately that the Lord would touch the heart of the only official who could annul or minimize the fine. How precious is the trying of your faith! Together with another sister and our youngest child we visited this man and explained our work to him. The Lord turned his heart toward us and he minimized the fine to an absolute minimum, \$60 instead of \$600. PTL! This was a tremendous victory but the fight wasn't over yet. I wasn't going to be satisfied till I had our passports in hand with the visas entered in.

During all this time we had been hitch hiking around this large city, doing all the paper work ourselves. The "mañana spirit" can be a real time waster here and finally, when all the paper work had been completed, I was told to return in a week. As I had already been away a week and needed to return to our work in the port city, I took another step of faith and went to talk with the person in charge of visas. It was a real fight and I had to wait a considerable amount of time, but in the final hour I got in to see him. The Lord really used our little child again and touched this man's heart. He immediately requested our papers in within a half hour I had our passports in hand with long term visas for all of us. What a miracle and victory for something that seemed so hopeless and a failure.

I am so grateful and relieved and thankful for the help that was given us by the family in the capital city and for my husband who encouraged me to fight and not give up. During this time the Lord also raised up several helpful people who chaffered us up to different destinations, many times going out of their way. One man very receptive and friendly, drove us back to our port home where he also lives and works.

Well, needless to say we learned to be very prayerful about with whom we entrust our legal papers with and that only faith succeeds. We knew it was the Lord's will for us to be here so we weren't going to give up. Where God guides He provides!

We want to especially thank you Dad and Maria for your counsel in the letters and your prayers. "Amen, Lord, if there's any of them need any special help or touch from you, an answer, Lord, or healing or whatever it might be, solving a problem, we ask that Thou shalt give it to them in Jesus' name." (#1064, par. 129) We know Dad if it wasn't for your encouragement and love, we would have never had the spiritual strength to keep going, asking, and receiving. AMEN! PTL! GBYAKY TYT!
