

While the dark shades can make satisfactory sun lenses, there are some drawbacks to these lenses. First, they do not absorb much infrared radia

tion. Secondly, they darken very little in a closed car because the window glass partially blocks the ultraviolet rays which activate the darkening process.

NIGHT DRIVING: Wearing sunglasses during the day can help your night driving. Just 2 or 3 hours of exposure to strong sunlight (without adequate protection) may slow the process of dark adaptation so that normal night vision is not reached for several hours. Sunglasses should be worn only when you actually need them. Regularly wearing sunglasses on cloudy days or in doors can make your eyes unnaturally sensitive to light.
