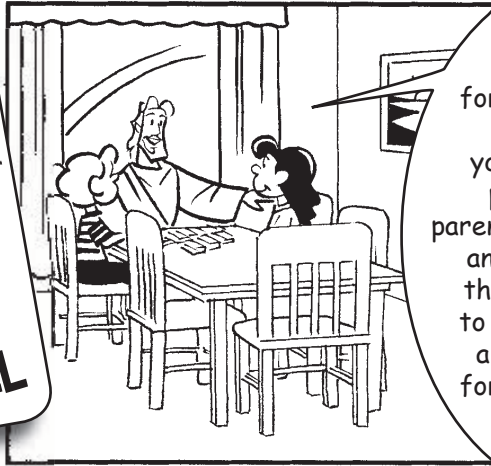
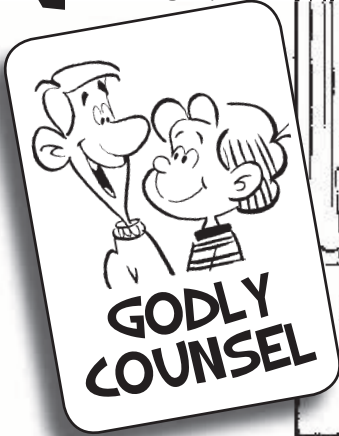




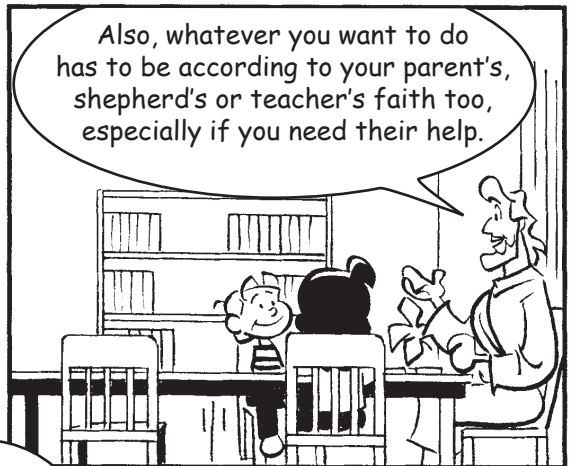
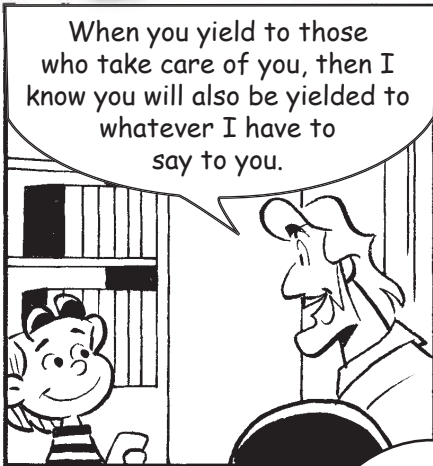
The **1ST** category is ...

Gideon said to God—

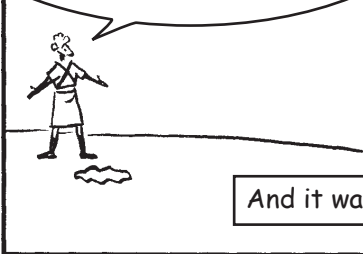
If You will save Israel by my hand as You have said ...

Then Gideon said to God—

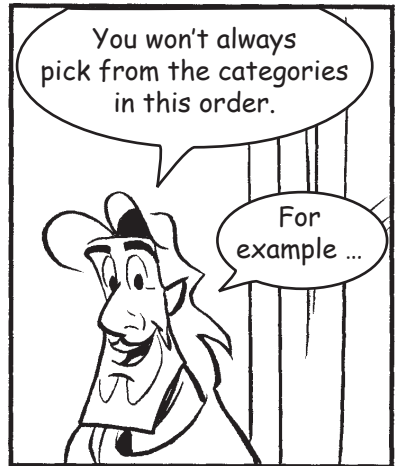
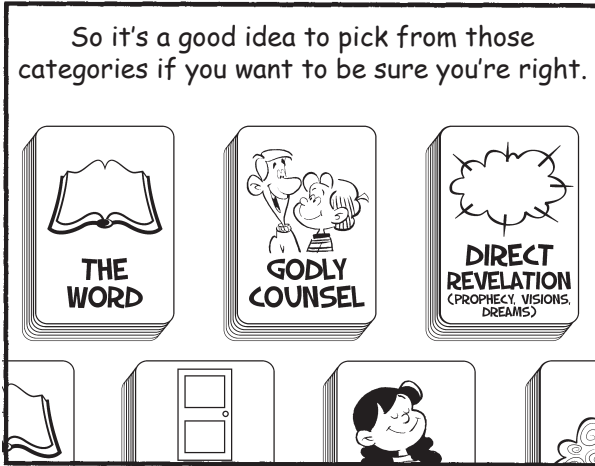
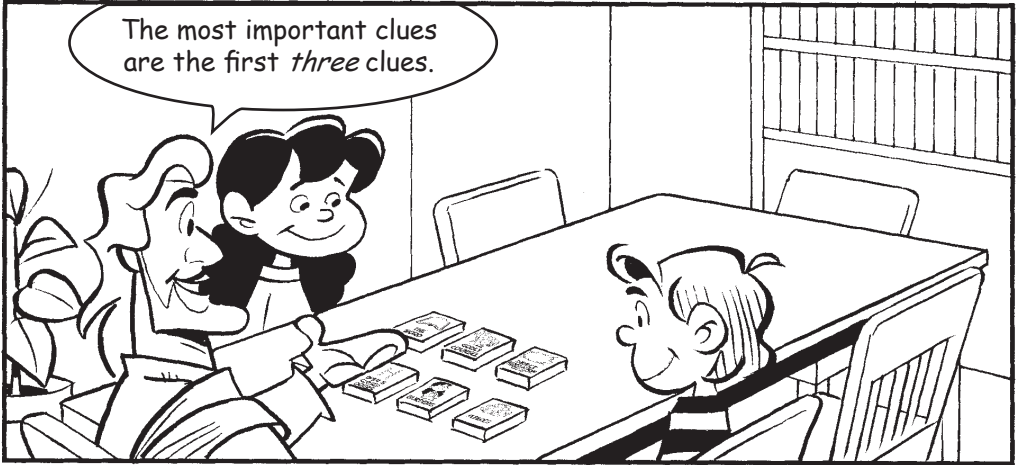
Do not be angry with me, but let me speak just once more:

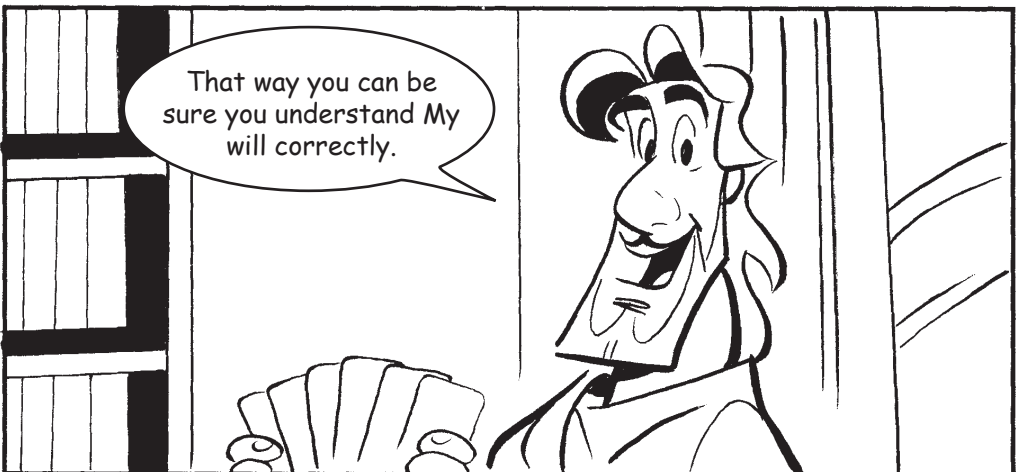
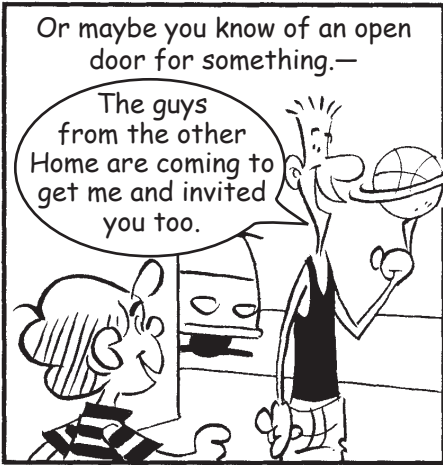
Let me test, I pray, just once more with the fleece; let it now be dry only on the fleece, but on all the ground let there be dew.

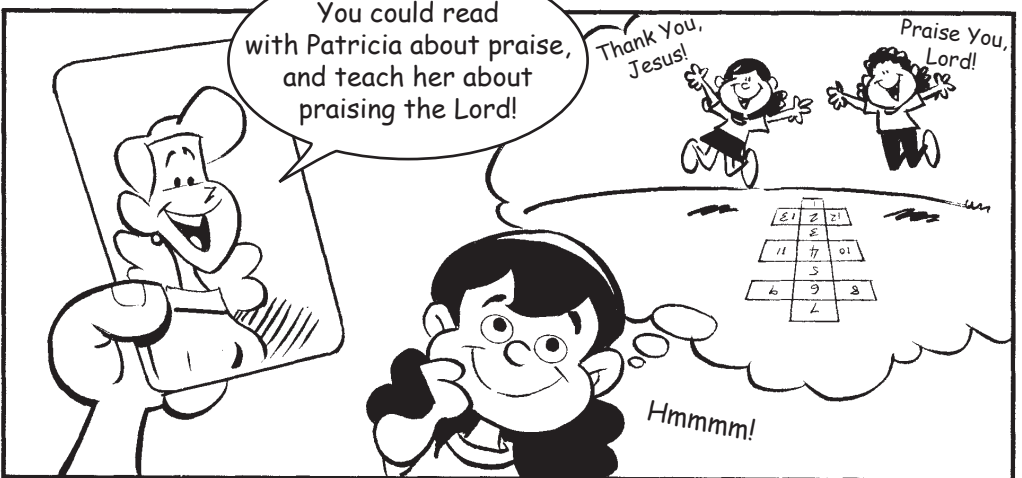
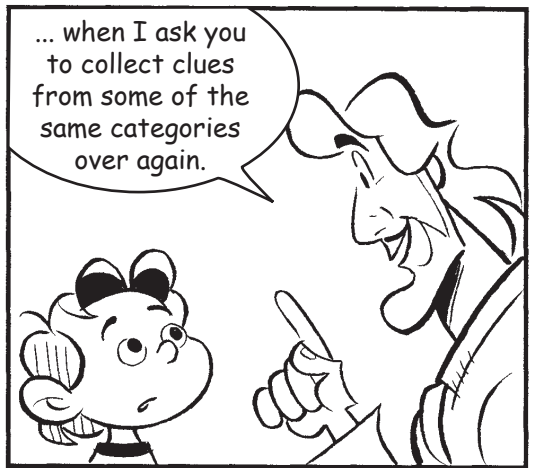


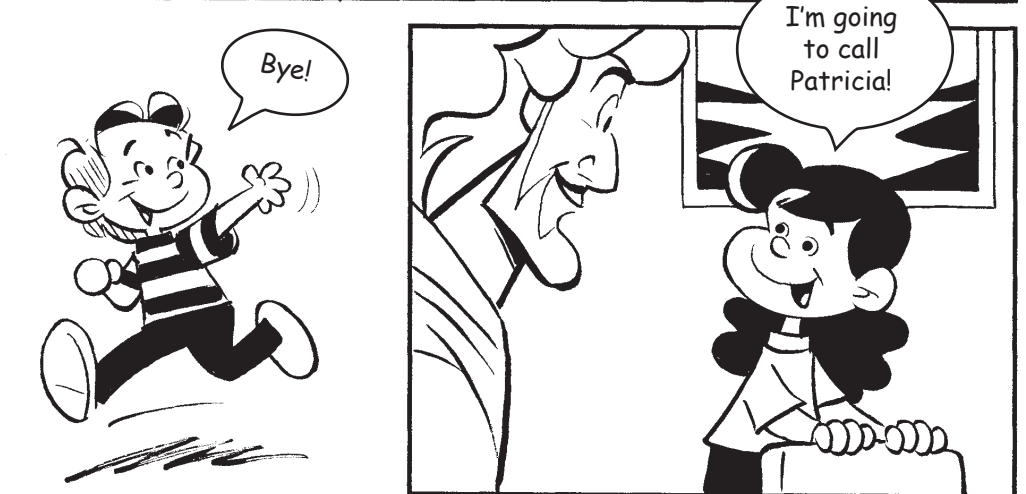
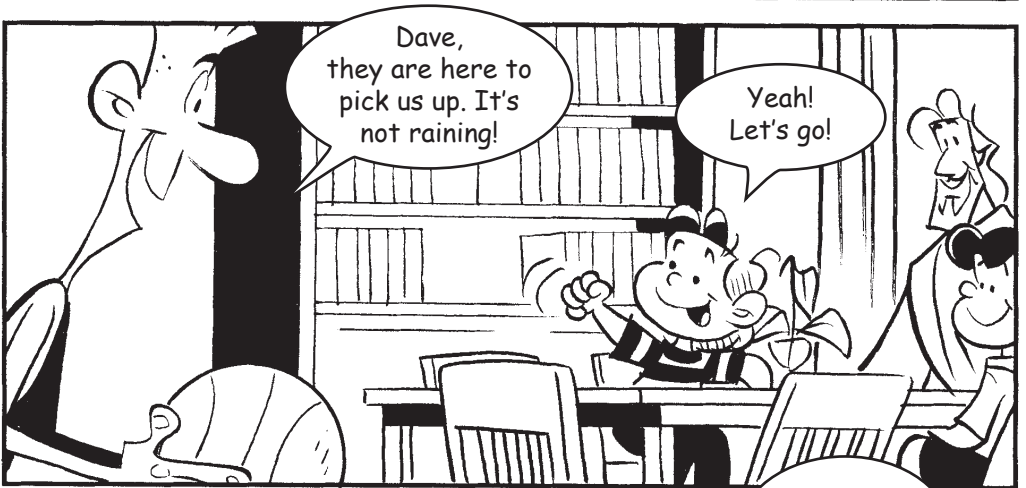
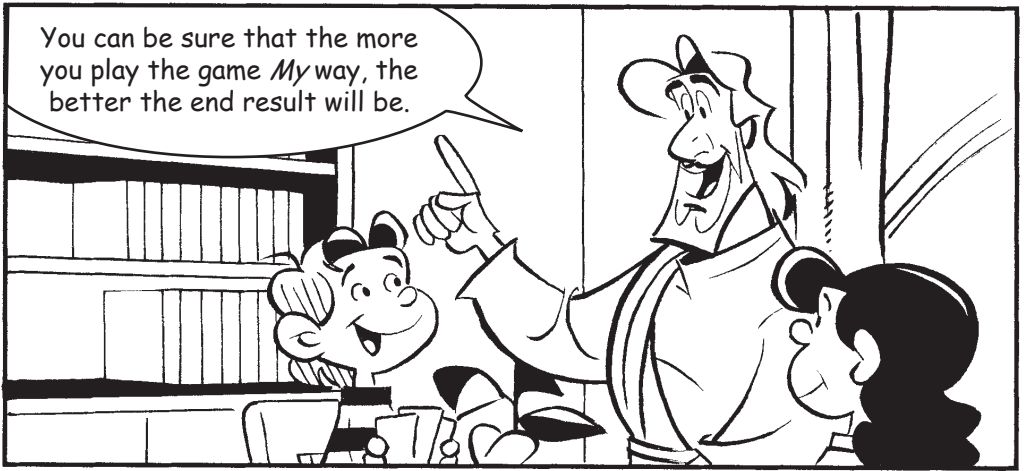
