There were multitudes of things he could learn right now! We began to encourage his motor development and to provide stimulation for all five senses and provoke his creativity

19. MARIA'S THE MOST FAITHFUL MOTHER any of us have ever seen in studying every bit of good child-rearing material she can get her hands on, including Mother's magazines, baby books, pamphlets, news articles, and especially pumping Daddy, the voice of wisdom and experience, for things she can share with all of us and the whole world.

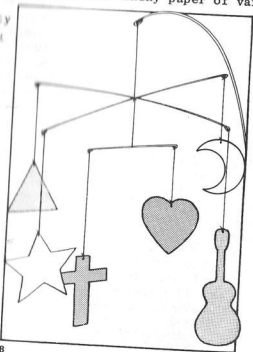

ING MOBILES so he wouldn't get bored always looking at the same thing, and she encouraged us to put nice, realistic coloured pictures on the wall, as well as a big mirror. Davidito also enjoyed a few stuffed animals to look at and talk to. You can make simple but beautiful mobiles yourself with shiny paper of var-



ious colours. You can easily cut shapes like circles, crosses, stars, hearts, crescents, yokes, guitars, pyramids etc. attaching them to strings and tie them to the ends of light-weight wire sticks and hang in a balanced, mobile fashion. Hung above the rocking chair, baby's bed or changing table, a mobile can keep a baby fascinated and interested as its first "toy".

22. WE FOUND THAT DAVIDITO AND OTHER SMALL BABIES who are very alert and awake much of the day just have to have something to do! Many people do not realize the capacity that a small infant has to enjoy and study and learn from the things around him, but the more we gave Davidito to do and learn from, the more he developed and progressed!

23. ALMOST EVERYDAY MOMMY AND DADDY WOULD MAKE A NEW SUGGESTION that would break our old "Childcare-doctrine" bottles, thank God! It was so interesting to see what suggestions they would make by the leading of the Spirit and by doing what was best for Little David.

24. DON'T FORGET THAT THEY HAD NEVER BEEN AROUND the stereotyped childcare centers that all of us nannies had come from! They had not been around the colony life, the children's colony or the regular routine that we had all known for so many years.

25. IT WAS A TRULY WHOLE NEW EXPERIENCE FOR EVERY ONE OF US that Rachel, Lydia, Alfred, Lucy and I and now others have all benefited greatly from. They believe in the simple rule:

26. DO WHAT IS BEST FOR THE

CHILD AND MAKES HIM HAPPY, and helps him learn and progress. Help him grow to be self-sufficient--feed his mind and spirit! Pray and obey, most of all!

27. WE WERE CONTINUALLY FEEDING HIS LITTLE MIND like a computer and trying to help Davidito develop all five senses with the freedom of his own natural curiosity. And most important of all, we strive to bring him up in a healthy spiritual atmosphere of God's love.

29. THIS MEANS WE MUST TRY TO UNDERSTAND the children as they start to learn and explore and fill their developing brain's need for stimuli and satisfying learning experiences.
