23. I TRULY BELIEVE THAT GOD'S WORD IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT "TOOLS" IN DISCIPLINING His little children in love. The Word cleanses and encourages their souls just as it does ours when we are chastised.

24. DAVIDITO RESPECTS THE WORD, therefore he really repents and receives victory when I share Scriptures with him about his behaviour--not in a condemning, harsh way, but in prayer or loving reminders, just as his Daddy and Mommy have mercifully "loved" me to victory many times! PTL!

25. FROM THIS AGE OF 27 MONTHS, DAVIDITO BEGAN TO MEMORISE SIMPLIFIED VERSES FROM THE KING JAMES BIBLE VERY EASILY. I simply repeated the verse to him many times throughout the day, along with the reference before and after the verse.

26. HE SEEMED TO JUST ABSORB THE SCRIPTURE and could easily and willingly quote it within a couple of days' time. It can be such fun to put verses to music in little songs, repeat them in prayers and just by inspiration throughout the day.

27. BEFORE THIS TIME, HE HAD EARILY LEARNED SEVERAL VERSES PUT TO SONG AND MUSIC, as children seem to almost instantly learn Scripture in this way! Have you ever noticed how much easier it is to memorise the Psalms that are put to music? Think how fun it would be to have the children's Scripture memory work put to music and rhymes! This way, the good Word of God is definitely a joy to learn and is certainly more important than some silly children's songs and nursery rhymes! MO and Maria think it

would be nice if our Family put much more Scripture to music. --What could be better?

28. LEARNING TO SING SCRIPTURE IN FOREIGN LANGUAGES ALSO COMES VERY EASY for the children to "absorb" in repetition and is an excellent witness to the public!

29. SHARING BIBLE STORIES AND SCRIPTURES WITH CHILDREN IS ONE OF THE MOST REWARDING, FUN AND FEEDING EXPERIENCES WE HAVE in raising our Family children! It's just like witnessing to a very receptive soul. It not only fills their immense vacuums but inspires and helps you as well, and helps you to walk in the Spirit together daily.

30. I BELIEVE MORE FAMILY MEMBERS NEED TO EXPERIENCE THIS JOY of training and "growing in the Word" along with our children. They would see what a tremendous blessing it is and never consider in the least that the "childcare ministry" is a laborious task that they do not feel called to.

31. THE CHILDREN NEED THE WORD! They seriously desire true answers about every facet in their busy little lives, and whatever Word of God you feed them will "never return void"! (Is.55:11.)

32. SOME OF THE BIG PEOPLE MAY HAVE LOST THEIR DESIRE to hide the Word in their hearts, but the little ones need and want it daily, and those who are responsible for their souls must feed them! (Ps.119:11, Jn.21:15.)

33. DAVIDITO AND I REVIEW SEVERAL VERSES TOGETHER DAILY when going potty or getting dressed. Most of the time I quote the verses and references for him. We usually talk about

the verses and relate it to some lesson we've learned, and then he will repeat the verses again, either alone or along with me. But the verses in song are the easiest and most fun to review!

34. PSALMS WHICH ARE ALREADY PUT TO MUSIC by the Family such as 23, 100, 121, 133, 150 should be sung to the children often so to "teach" them these precious promises from babyhood on up!

35. I NEVER HAVE DAVIDITO REPEAT OR RECITE VERSES TO ME IN A "TESTING" MANNER! He almost always gives the verse out again in the same inspirational-type way that it was presented to him and he has learned to relate Scripture to pertinent incidences in his daily life.

36. WE ONCE SANG AND RECITED ALL HIS MEMORY WORK ONTO TAPE and he loved hearing that same tape many times over before bedtime. If the Word is a vital part of your life as it should be, the children will hear it every day and absorb every bit. Only in this way can we expect them to be the strong soldiers they must be to win the world for Jesus!

37. NOW AT THE AGE OF THREE, DAVIDITO KNOWS VERY WELL AROUND 100 SCRIPTURES, as well as some basic MO quotes from the children's editions of the Letters!

38. REMEMBER THAT WHATEVER YOU DO IN TEACHING THE CHILDREN, ESPECIALLY IN SPIRITUAL AND REVOLUTIONARY DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING in their little lives, which is most important, make it fun and challenging! If they aren't enjoying learning it, you must not be enjoying teaching it!

39. TIME IS SHORT AND THEIR LIVES ARE SO MOLDABLE and so full of opportunity for learning! We

need to take advantage of every fruitful method at every opportune moment for filling them with God's Love and Word! I love you and hope this is as much a help for you as it has been for our little Prince. God bless you always in His love.
