He knows, he's smart enough right now, he knows all these words and recognises them, he could easily speak if he wanted to!

25. "I WOULDN'T BE SURPRISED

IF HE UNDERSTANDS THEIR SPANISH EVEN BETTER! After all, if he's got spiritual helpers, relatives, his ancestors who are helping him, as we obviously all have, then it must be that they're trying to influence him.

26. "I HAD THE SNEAKING FEELING THAT THEY DON'T LIKE US TEACHING HIM ONLY ENGLISH, but how are we going to teach him Spanish until we've taught him English? 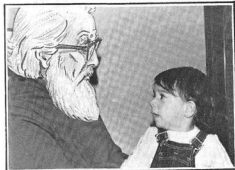


27. TIME WITH DADDY: WHAT A SIGHT WHEN DAVIDITO CARRIED A BIG
