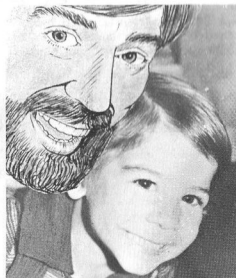


small French restaurant. He said one night, "He really responds well, doesn't he? I'm sure he understands everything we're saying, and even what we're thinking."

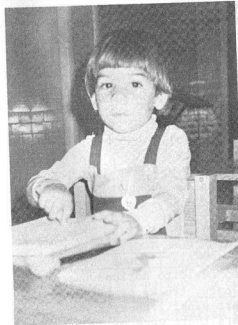
