17. DADDY THOUGHT HE'D TRY TO OFFER DAVID A LIT-TLE INCENTIVE to finish a seal by writing him a note that after he ate all his meal & a good dinner he could come to their room. But just so not to have to comply with any new restrictions, Davidito refused to eat a bite! We tried to make things as pleasant as possible & not mag him to eat, but he didn't care. So he didn't get to see

Mommy & Daddy. Later in the evening Mommy wrote him a note saying, "I'm sorry you didn't get to come see us, & we hope you eat all your food tomorrow." But next morning at breakfast when we reminded him of the noteagain, no meal! He certainly didn't starve. but he & we all had some lessons to learn



family after dinner .-- Here's snacktime on the floor & that' thru this stage, the paper trash can for my hat! which, thanks to the Lord & desperate prayer soon passed.

18. MOMMY & DADDY SAID IT'S IMPORTANT HE LEARN NOT TO WASTE FOOD he's offered at mealtimes & he should be allowed to serve himself his own portions. That way he chooses how much he wants & usually takes a little of each main dish; if he wants more, he'll ask for it! Otherwise, if we serve his plate, he doesn't eat as well. Perhaps we were serving too much on his plate & it discouraged him from eating at all!

19. HE LIKES VERY MUCH THE STORIES THAT MOMMY & DADDY READ TO HIM. He learned from Daddy's lesson from Aesop's Fables how to rebuke a dog by saying "Go away, dog, in Jesus' name!" & pointing a stick at the dog. Daddy explained that he is the Shepherd & David is a lamb & we are all sheep, David then asked if everyone in the house was a sheep, naming each person. That night when preparing to go out FFing I told him I was going to witness to God's sheep the Love of Jesus, & David said, "Sara, I'm a sheep!" (Hint, hint!) 20. HE LOOKS FORWARD SO TO READING A MO LETTER

he says, "Let's read a Letter & get in the Spirit!", or he'll entice us into reading with him, "Now Alf, I want to read you some MO Letters; I've been reading so many tonight for myself I think I'm really going to be in the Spirit!" 21. 22. ONE NIGHT WHEN DAVIDITO WAS PLAYING WITH ARMEN HE SLIPPED & BUMPED HIS HEAD ON THE HARD FLOOR. He screamed out in fear A embarrassment because neither Alf nor I were nearby, & by the time I ran to him he was almost hysterical, screaming out very loudly. I was trying to get his mind off the fact that it burt & tell him it wasn't necessary to scream, but I really didn't handle the situation right because I said to him "It doesn't hurt it we prayed for it" -- when I knew for sure that it did hurt very much!

23. I SHOULD HAVE CUDDLED HIM MORE & RELIEVED HIS EMBARRASSMENT & fright rather than say it didn't hurt at all. The prayer & Scriptures would've helped more than my own sermons anyway! And did you ever notice how a child "tunes in" & closely observes your reaction to hurting yourself or making a mistake? Convicting, huh? 24. WHENEVER DADDY GREETS ME WITH A HUG & A KISS & A COUPLE OF SQUEEZES he prays for my love & wisdom above all in taking care of Davidito. He says when Solomon prayed for wisdom the Lord gave him everything along with it! So pray for love & wisdom daily for the Lord's help in raising His little ones! 25. THE LORD REALLY INCREASED & BLESSED OUR

FAITH WHEN WE WENT TO THE AMERICAN NEIGHBOUR-HOOD nearby & asked around if anyone knew of a little red wagon for sale or to give away.
