10. I slapped his face for it the second time I heard him do it because I had already warned him about it the time before. & he's trying now to improve on that to prevent his getting another slap.

12. ONE MORNING IN THE SCHOOLROOM I left him & Richard to finish an art project, but when I returned. David had the entire tin of pens & pencils dumped all over the floor & was throwing them around the room! I quickly spanked his hand two times, which is not such a hard punishment, but he was so mad & embarrassed that I'd done it, that he didn't cry at first, but hatefully stared me down, then burst out crying & nearly fainted like he used to do when he would bump his head! I was so surprised that I held him in my arms & prayed & when he came around without having altogether fainted, I talked to him very seriously about it. He was still very mad with me all day for spanking him in front of Richard.

13. ONE OTHER TIME THIS MONTH HE GOT SPANKED for being defiant with Alf. & as soon as he got swatted on the bottom he again acted as if he was going to faint. but just barely sort of collapsed. This made me really examine my heart to make sure I was really justified in spanking him, because it seems to be not only a very angry reaction, but a somewhat fearful one, Tike maybe he is a bit afraid of what we are going to do to him, or even of what he himself is going to do uncontrollably, I'm not sure. Of course, it's a type of spiritual attack too, that prayer always overcomes with victory! We are continually reminding him to keep his hands out of his mouth, a nervous habit developed recently.

14. EXCURSIONS: OFF TO THE AIRPORT FOR MY BIRTHDAY EXCURSION! Now I can see why Alf & David love going there so much -- it's very educational, a modern deluxe-type of airport, very conducive to learning.
