A TREASURE CHEST

Materials: Use a cardboard box (with lid) about 18" long, 9" high, 9" wide such as a candy box or small chest with hinged lid. If possible, spray gold. Fasten Bible to top of chest. Place in the chest gold jewelry, food, compass, flashlight, cardboard sword covered with aluminum foil, hammer, mirror, package of seed, bottle of water, milk carton, musical instrument, bottle of medicine.

Suggestions for talk: Explain that the Bible is a Treasure Chest containing all that we need to guide us. Take out the treasures and talk about each one:

Gold: Psalm 119:127 God's Word is more precious than treasures of gold and jewelry.

Food: Jeremiah 15:16; Psalm 119:103 Just as we enjoy eating good food, we love to read God's Word and benefit from the spiritual strength that it gives.

Compass: Psalm 16:11 God's Word will help to direct our lives if we read it daily.

Light: Psalm 119:105 God's Word is like light that shows the way along a dark path.

Weapons: Hebrews 4:12 If we know how to use God's Word, it will protect us against our enemy, the devil. God's Word is a shield of safety.

Tool: Jeremiah 23:29 If we read God's Word, the message will break the hardest rock of stubbornness, anger or lies in our lives.

Mirror: James 1:23,25 We read that God's Word is like a looking glass that shows what is wrong with us.

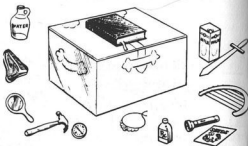
Seed: Matthew 13:23 God's Word is like a seed. When planted in the heart it produces a fruitful Christian life.

Water: Psalm 119:9; John 4:14 God's Word is like water that cleanses from sin and satisfies spiritual thirst.

Milk: 1 Peter 2:2 God's Word nourishes Christians.

Musical Instruments: Psalm 33:1-4 His Word in the heart causes the Christian to sing and be joyful.

Medicine: Psalm 107:20 God's Word is like a medicine that heals our heartaches and troubles.
