19. CROSS REFERENCES SHOULD OF COURSE BE LATED TO YOUR SUBJECT VERSE. For Genesis 1:26 refer to John 1:1--Jesus was there! Read Colossians 1:15 & 16 to the children while searching through the Scriptures. take advantage of this opportunity to find Bible verses for himself. Genesis 1:14, talks about how lights are "for signs & seasons". Refer to Matthew 24:29 & 30 to see how the sun, moon & stars will be used as signs at the Second Coming of Jesus. 20. MEMORY VERSE: GENESIS 1:1. The very first Rible verse is one of the most imm portant answers to many people's questions about God & the World we live in Many people who have a difficult time be lieving the first verse of the Bible may have a hard time believing the rest of it! What is "Evolution"? Why do "school" books always teach it when the Bible shows it's not true? Talk about Romans 1:20-32.

22. MO LETTERS: Refer to "Bible In Pictures" chapter 1, paragraphs 1 - 9. (ML No. 642.) Who could say it better than Dad, Amen? After all, if Dad hasn't said it of verified it somehow, you never really know if other Bible teachings are accurate, so stick mainly to God's Word & the Letters! See Komix "The Big Lie", "God's Creation Vs. Man's Creation" by Hart, Soliourn's "Naming the Animals".

23. SPELLING WORDS: light, water, land, day, night (use Copy-Test-Prove Method explained in Part One).

24. DICTIONARY WORDS: dominion, vs.28; firmament vs.8.

25. RESEARCH TOPICS: Refer to your World Map to find & talk about the five oceans & various seas. Large land areas are called "continents", small land areas are

called "islands". What continent do you live on? Do you know any Family living o & isn't that just what we want to happen!? islands? Trace a large, clear World Map 18. CHILDREN LOVE THE CREATION SONG FROM onto paper & label the five oceans & seven continents. Discuss cold lands & warm, Nicolas Robinhood. This song also makes a tropical lands & climates. A mural of the Creation could be done simply with litips of rug yarn glued onto an outline first sketched. The outline is traced with a light coat of glue such as limer's or Ducco cement from a tube (heavy enough
