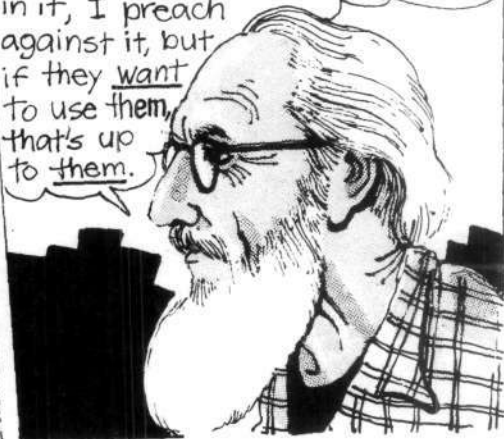
And what good reason would you have for smoking pot as a witness?

to them.

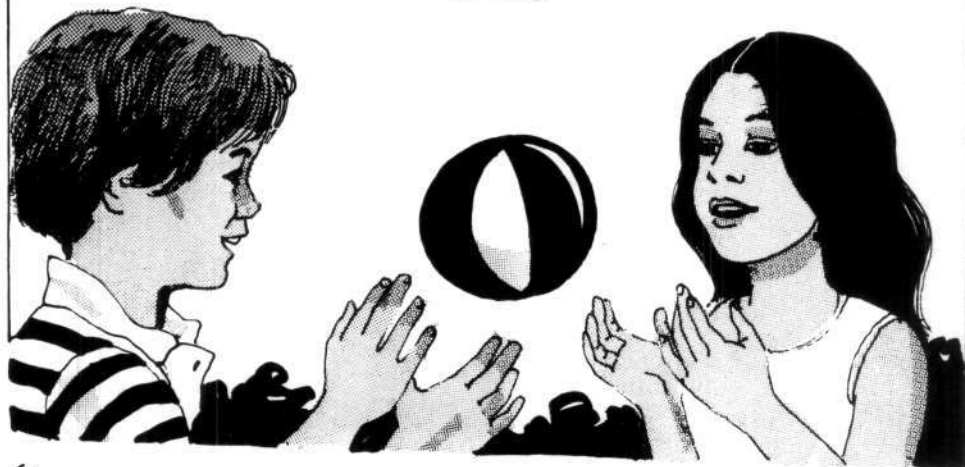


(A more difficult question is where a couple with
