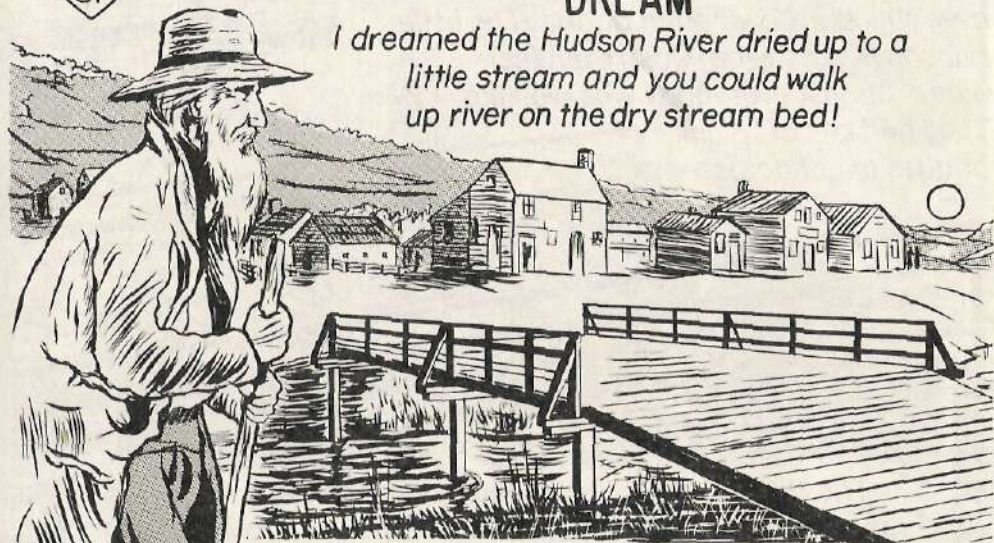




THE HUDSON RIVER "DREAM"

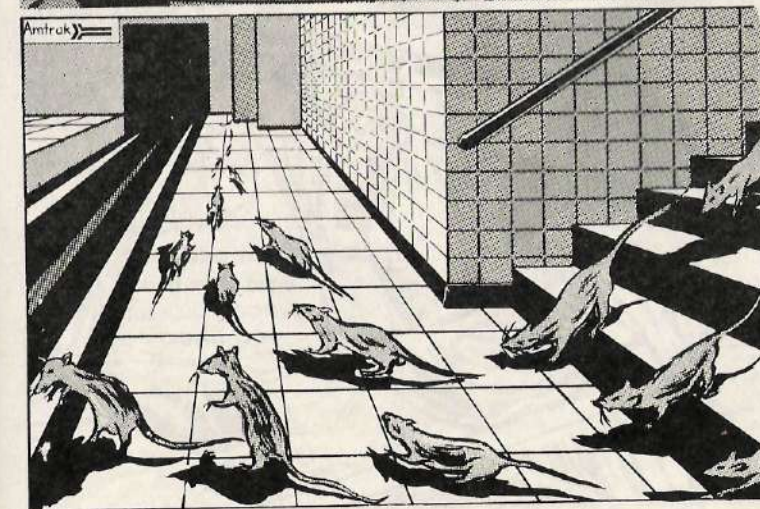
The Hudson River just ended in a great big hole. It just dropped off where New York City used to be!
