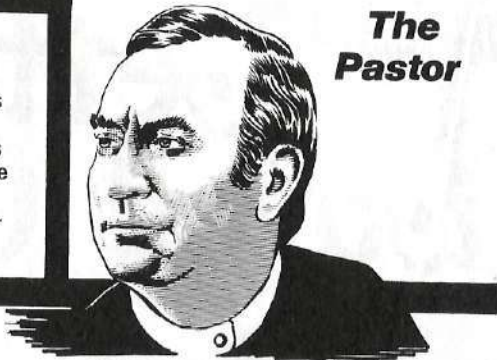

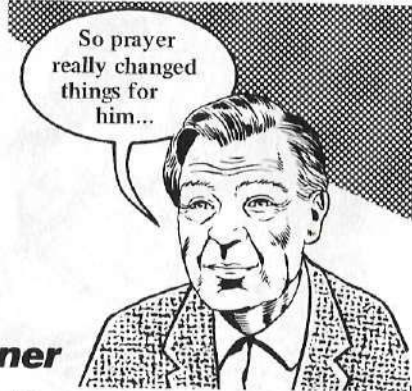

So prayer really changed things for him...

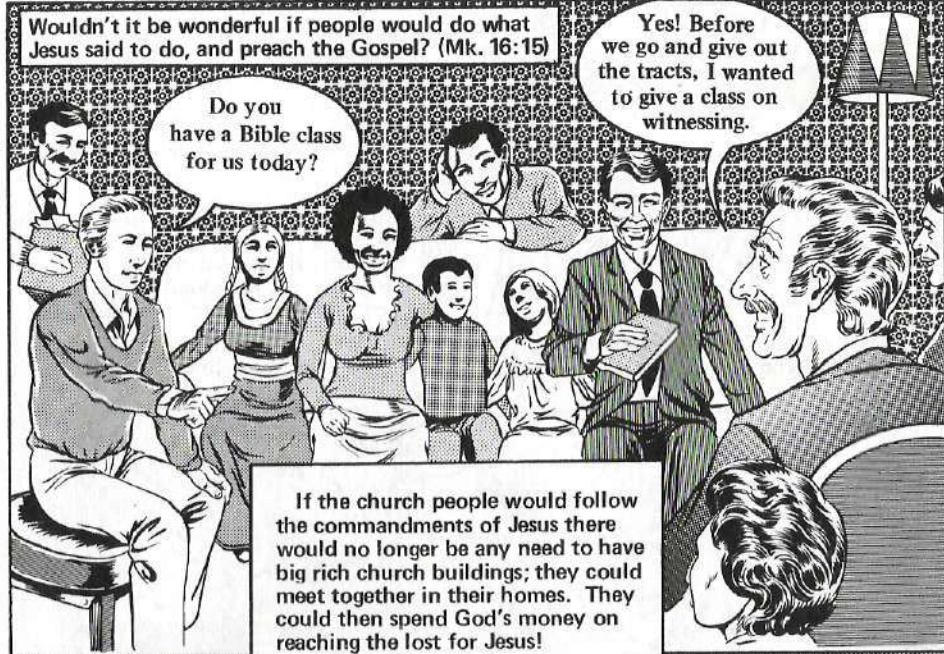


Praise the Lord! Both he and his wife got saved!

Hmm ...well, we're running a little late today. Perhaps we can skip the prayer and hymn and go straight into the collection.....

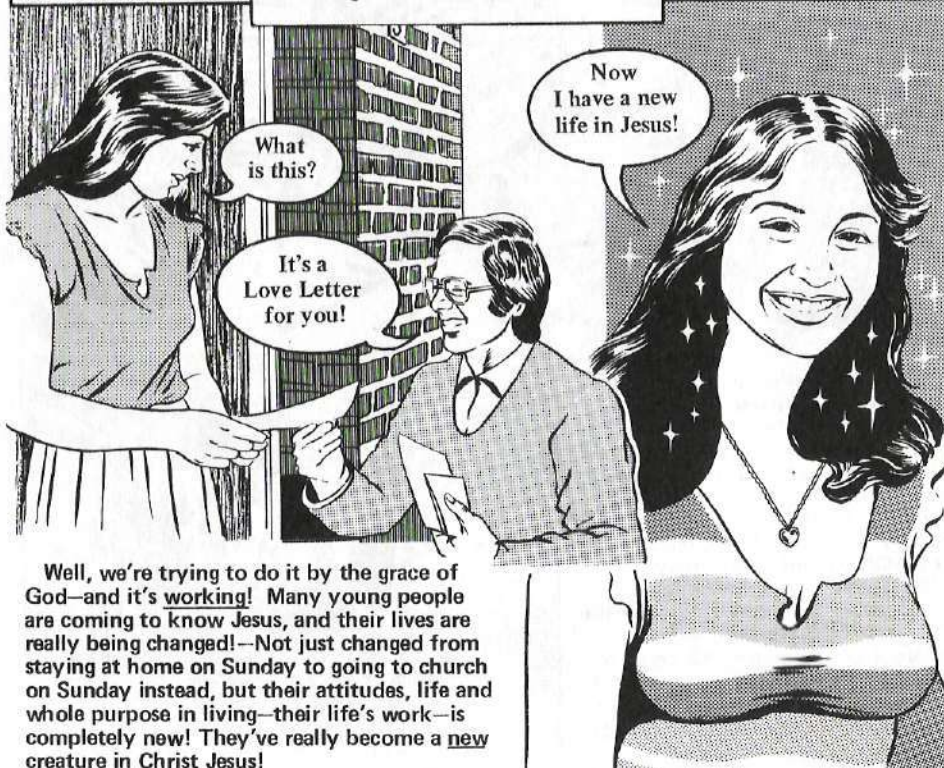


Wouldn't it be wonderful if people would do what Jesus said to do, and preach the Gospel? (Mk. 16:15)

Cheer up, God can use you if you'd ask Him if He would!

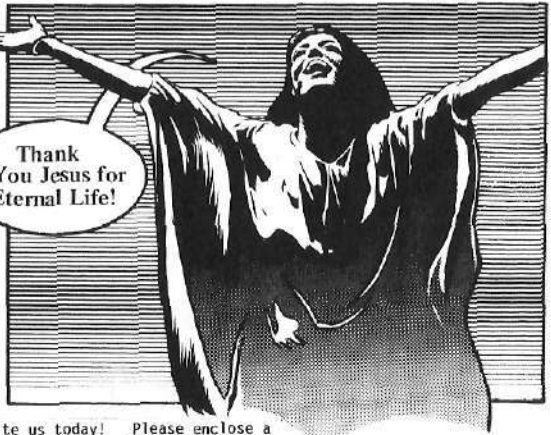
